The criminal justice system in San Mateo County is undergoing significant changes.

Earlier this year, Governor Jerry Brown signed legislation designed to close the revolving door of low-level inmates cycling in and out of state prison. The bill, AB 109, transfers responsibility for supervising certain low-level inmates from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to counties.

San Mateo County is currently developing strategies to:

- Supervise parolees to protect public safety
- Improve educational and work-training programs to reduce recidivism
- Help former inmates successfully re-enter society

The San Mateo County Probation Department invites you to a town hall meeting to hear your ideas. The Probation Department will incorporate ideas from the community in the County's local Public Safety Realignment Implementation Plan.
