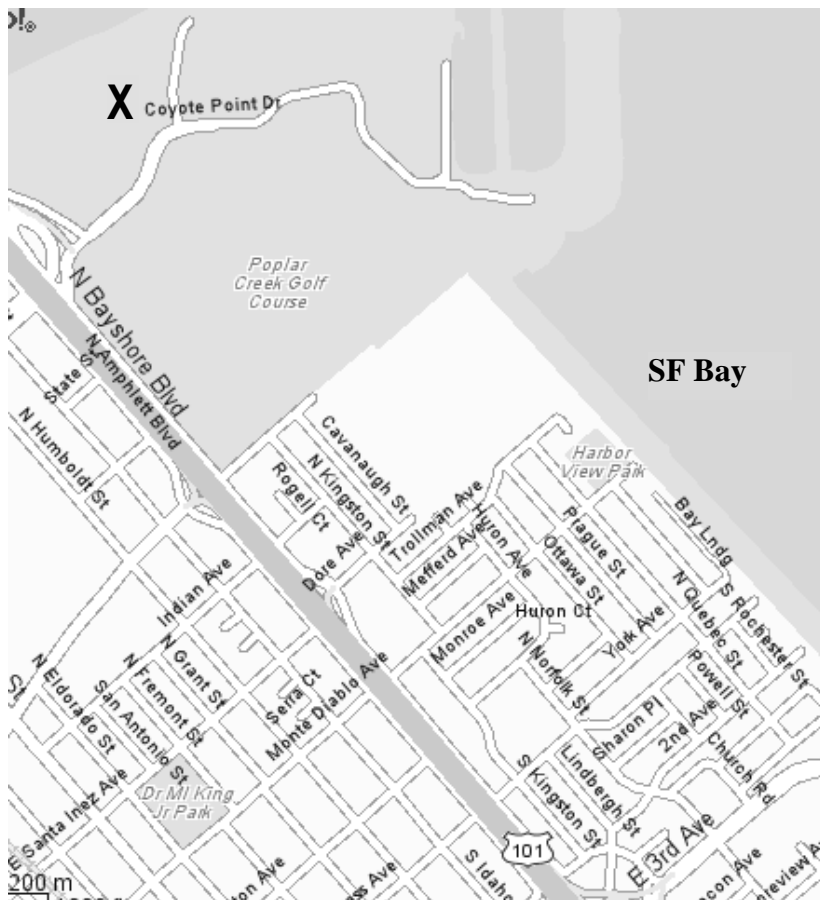
Directions to Coyote Point Park
1961 Coyote Point Drive, San Mateo

From the north (San Francisco), use Highway 101 South. Take the Poplar Avenue exit. Turn right onto Humboldt St; until Peninsula Avenue. Turn right onto Peninsula Avenue. Go over the freeway, and then circle around and into the Park.

From the south (San Jose), use Highway 101 North. Take the Dore Avenue exit. Immediately turn left onto North Bayshore Boulevard. Turn right onto Coyote Point Drive to the park.
