Summary:

On November 23, 1983, an adult African American male was found near Cooley Landing in East Menlo Park in a marshy area. The remains were partially clothed in blue jeans, belt with buckle and a pair of tennis shoes. The decedent is believed to be approximately 30 years old and had old facial trauma to the nose and left eye area. His lower wisdom teeth were removed and he had been dead for 1-1.5 years. Facial reconstruction completed.
