You may be eligible to receive assistance for the following expenses through the Victim Compensation Program after all other sources of reimbursement are used:

- Medical/Dental Expenses
- Counseling Expenses
- Wage or Income Loss
- Support Loss for Dependents
- Funeral/Burial Expenses
- Crime Scene cleanup
- Home Security Improvements
- Moving/Relocation Expenses

The program cannot pay for lost, damaged or stolen property including cash, or Pain and Suffering.

Violent Crimes may include but are not limited to:

- Domestic Violence
- Sexual Assault
- Child Abuse
- Assault
- Homicide
- Hit & Run
- Elder Abuse
- Robbery
- Driving Under the Influence
- Criminal Threats

Victims may suffer either physical injury and /or emotional harm as a result of the crime. We provide a list of therapists who are available to assist victim(s) and their immediate family with counseling.

Advocates are available to provide assistance, referrals to community resources, information and updates on court cases.

The services we offer are free of charge, and there is no legal citizenship requirement in order for you to receive assistance.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Report the crime to law enforcement
- Cooperate with law enforcement in the arrest and prosecution of the offender
- Have no involvement or contribution in the crime resulting in your injuries
- Apply for compensation of losses through the Victim Compensation Program, within one year from the date of crime.
