Identifying the New Normal – Continuing and Emerging Trends for the Next Five Years

You are invited to participate in a public input meeting to gather and re-confirm housing and community development needs and priorities for the County of San Mateo and the Cities of South San Francisco and Daly City. Each of us is beginning the development of a new five-year Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) for the use of one or more HUD annual entitlement funds, which we each distribute for qualified programs and activities. (The Cities of San Mateo and Redwood City are on different five-year Con Plan cycles.)

The County, South San Francisco, and Daly City each get Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The County and Daly City also get our own Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) funds. The County alone gets Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds for countywide use.
