

Medi-Cal


Medi-Cal provides free or low cost health insurance to eligible adults, children and seniors.

Who can benefit from Medi-Cal?

- Under 21 years of age
- Over 65 years of age
- Blind
- Disabled
- Parents of children under 21
- A pregnant woman
- In a skilled nursing or long-term facility
- Receiving SSI/SSP or CalWORKs
- Those who meet income and resource guidelines

What else should I know?

- If you have a medical emergency, you can ask your worker to process your case right away.
- You can apply for Medi-Cal even if you have another type of insurance.
- In some cases, Medi-Cal can help pay for Medicare premiums.
- Applications are usually processed in 45 days (90 days for disability applications). If you have an emergency, we may be able to help you right away.

Resources

Checking and savings account statements, savings bonds, stock certificates or retirement accounts
