Subject: **Hillside Boulevard Resurfacing – South San Francisco Area

### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution adopting plans and specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for the resurfacing of a portion of Hillside Boulevard.

### Previous Board Action

1. Adopted Resolution No. 63445 on February 29, 2000, authorizing an application for Eight (8) Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP). Project funding to partially finance the resurfacing project.
2. Authorized the Director of Public Works to execute agreements with Public Agencies, utility companies and special districts for utility type work less than \$25,000 proposed to be done in conjunction with County road projects.

### Key Facts

1. The proposed project is part of our overall program to preserve the County maintained road system.
2. The project qualifies for funds available through the Federal Surface Transportation Program.

### Discussion

The proposed project consists of grinding the existing pavement, and resurfacing the road with asphalt concrete within the above-described limits.

The San Mateo County Planning Department has determined that this project is exempt from the requirements for preparation of an EIR under Section 15301(C) Class 1, of the California Environmental Quality Act and we have filed a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk.

Caltrans, which administers the Federal funding, has authorized us to proceed with advertising for bids for the work.

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**Fiscal Impact**


The total estimated cost of construction is \$231,000 and is proposed to be financed as follows:

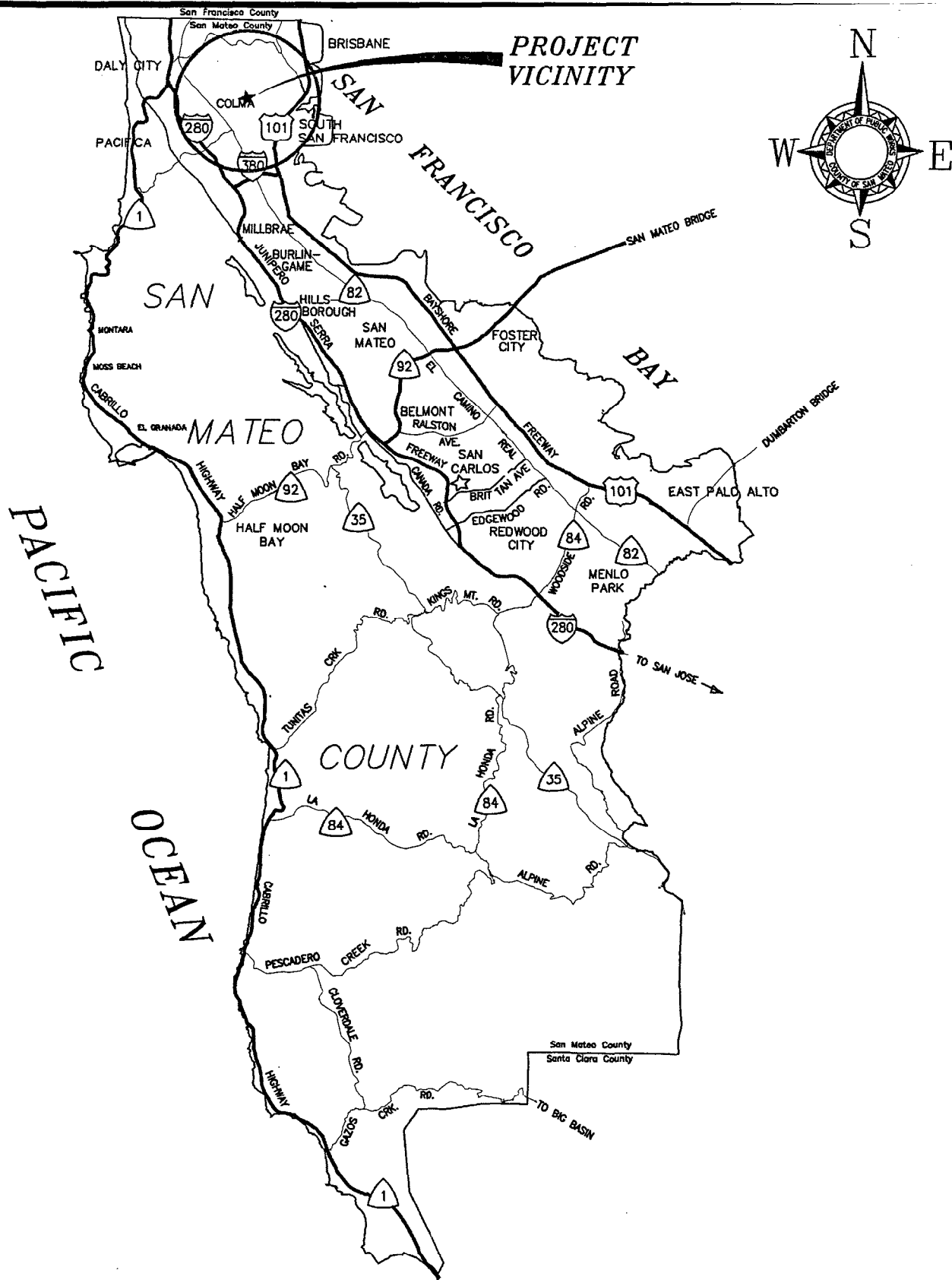
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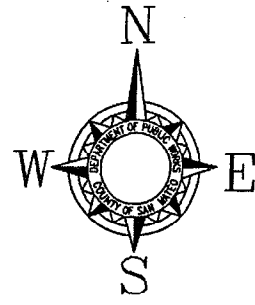

**PROJECT VICINITY**



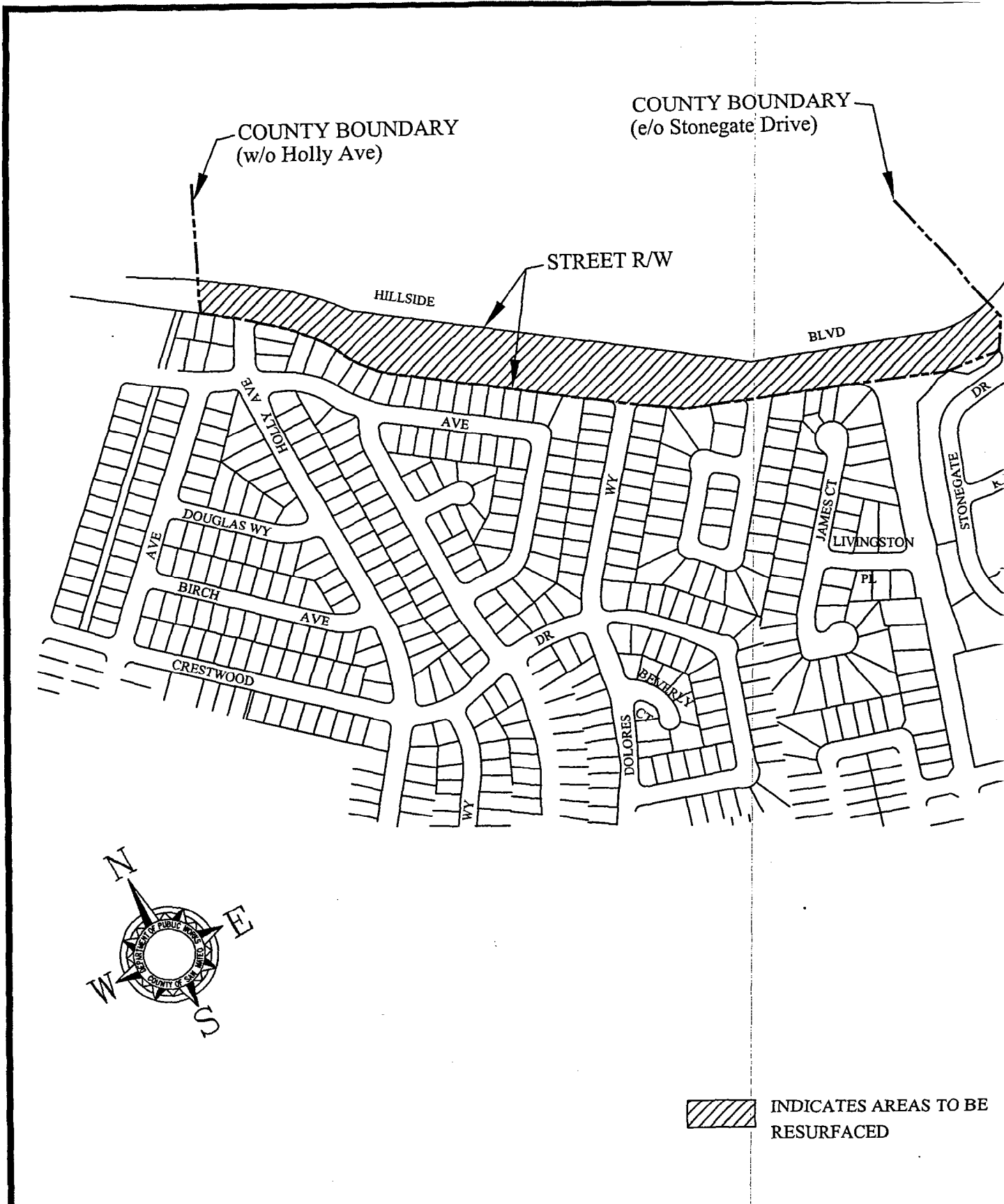

 VICINITY MAP**

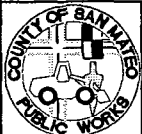

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**Resolution Adopting Plans and Specifications, Determining Prevailing Wage Scales and Calling for the Sealed Proposals for Hillside Boulevard Resurfacing – City of South San Francisco Area, Federal Project Number STPL-5935 (021) 04-SM-0-CR**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, Plans and Specifications have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the resurfacing of the aforementioned road listed above, and said Plans and Specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

**WHEREAS**, a schedule of prevailing wage scales for each craft or type of workman needed to execute this contract in the locality in which said work is to be performed has been established by the Department of Industrial Relations and has been referred to in said Specifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Plans and Specifications dated July 20, 2001, for the aforementioned project, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved of and adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be

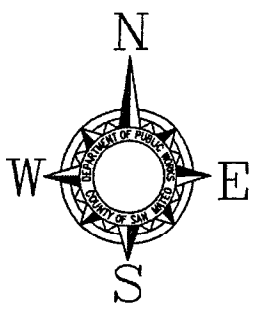
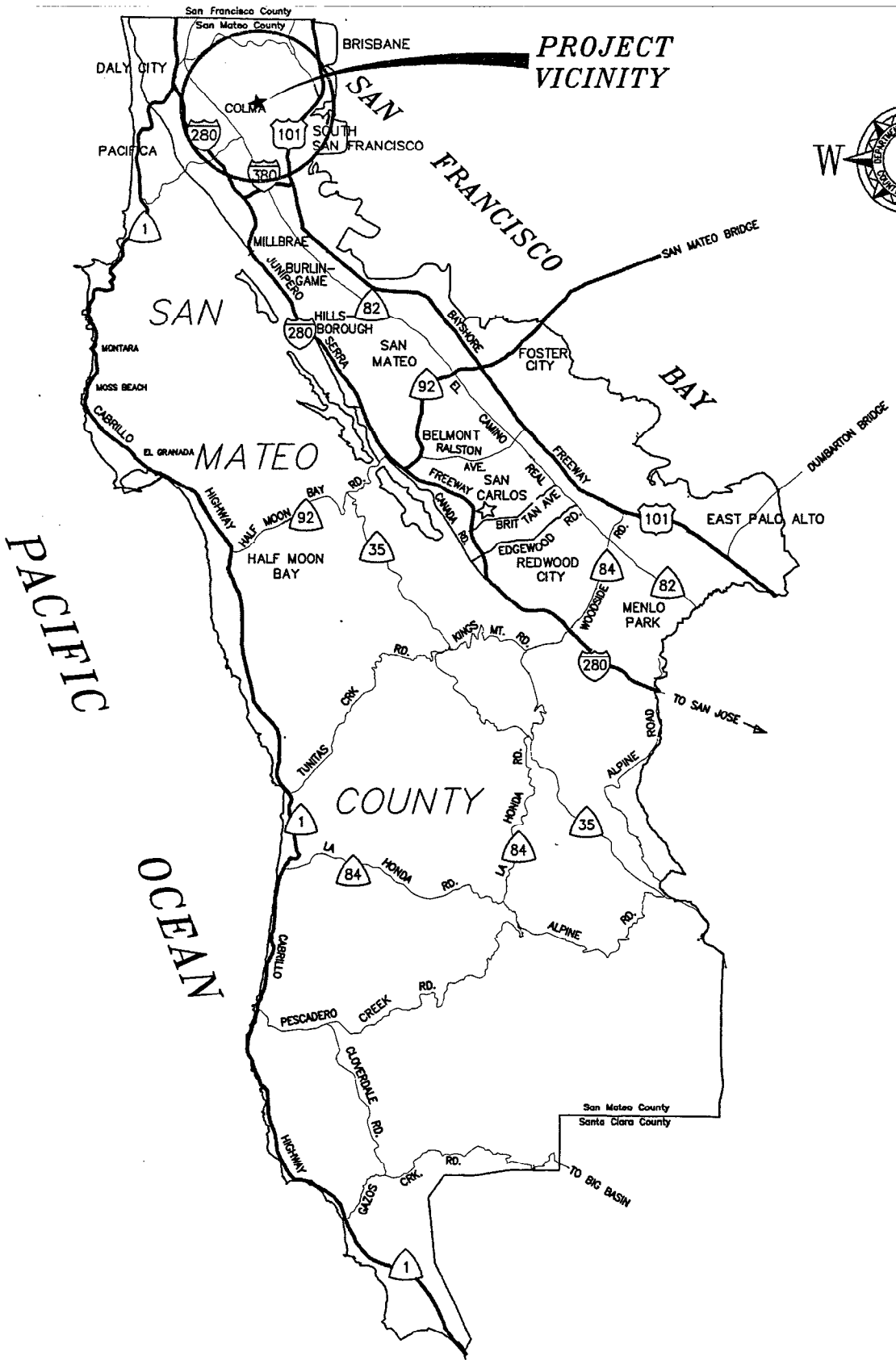
adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.

2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.

3. The Department of Public works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received at the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, on or before 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 11, 2001 in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices in the Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California. Said bids will then be publicly opened and declared in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices.

The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed proposals to be published two (2) times in the Independent Newspaper Group, a newspaper printed and published in this County; and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

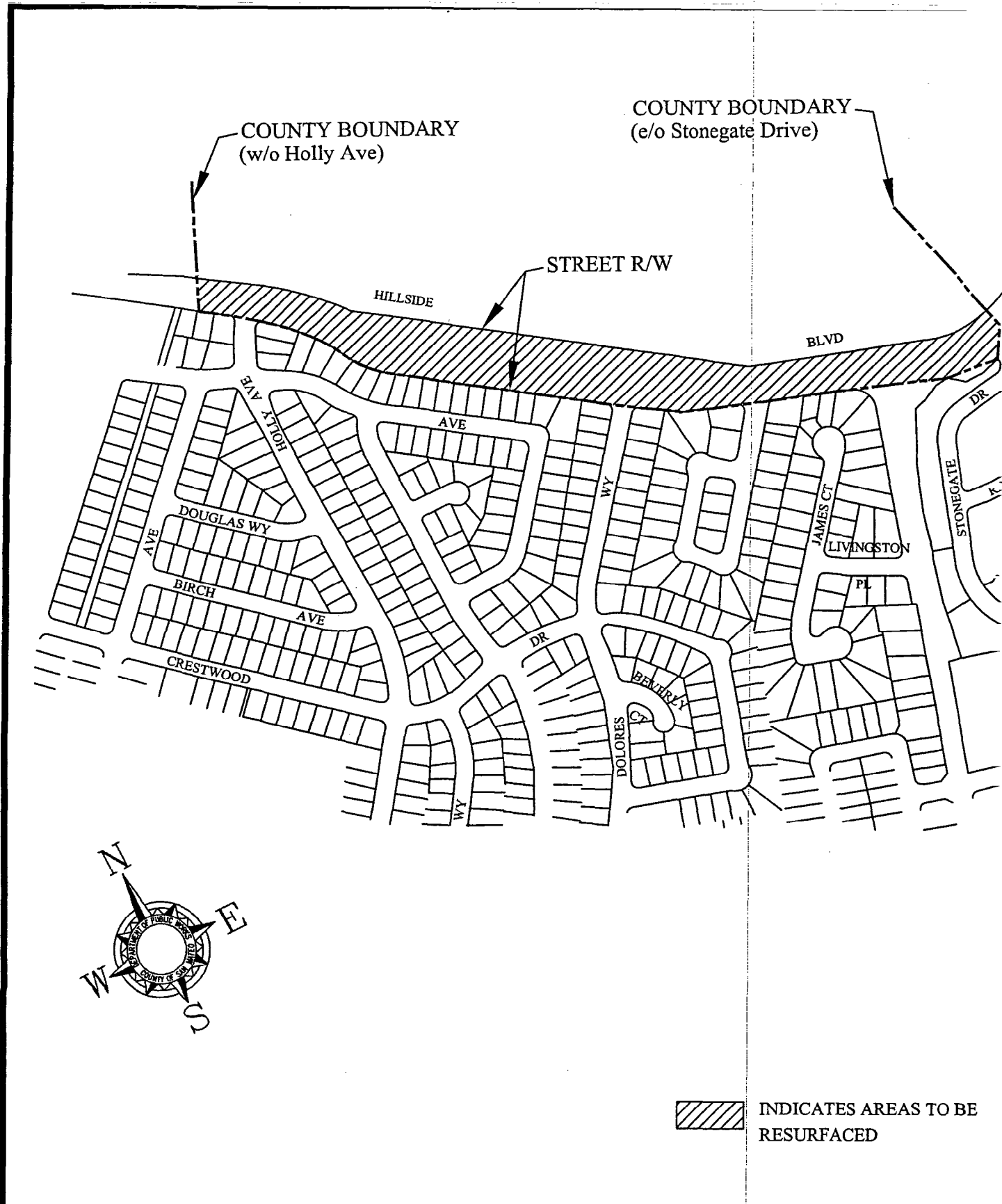
**HILLSIDE BLVD RESURFACING
