Based upon the Board's action at the last meeting, the subcommittee is submitting for the Board's consideration, the redistricting plan previously identified as Scenario Three. This proposed plan would move the Redwood Shores area from District Four to District Three. In addition, an area south of Ralston Avenue in Belmont would move from District Three to District Two. Also, adjustments would be made in San Mateo by moving certain areas west of El Camino Real from District Two to District One. As indicated at the last Board meeting, the subcommittee also reexamined the boundary between District Five and District One in the San Bruno area, and is now recommending that the current boundary between those two districts be maintained and that all San Bruno remain in District One.

The subcommittee recommends that the Board, after the public hearing, introduce the ordinance as currently recommended by the subcommittee.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.176.020, 2.176.030, 2.176.040, 2.176.050 AND 2.176.060 OF CHAPTER 2.176, TITLE 2 OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS

follows:

Section 2.176.020 First Supervisorial District:

The First Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County depicted in the attached map entitled, "Map of Supervisorial District One," an enlargement of which can be viewed in either the Department of Information Services or Public Works.

SECTION 2. Section 2.176.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.176.030 Second Supervisorial District:

The Second Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County depicted in the attached map entitled, "Map of Supervisorial District Two," an enlargement of which can be viewed in either the Department of Information Services or Public Works.

SECTION 3. Section 2.176.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.176.040 Third Supervisorial District:

The Third Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County depicted in the attached map entitled, "Map of Supervisorial District Three," an enlargement of which can be viewed in either the Department of Information Services or Public Works. SECTION 4. Section 2.176.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.176.050 Fourth Supervisorial District:

The Fourth Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County depicted in the attached map entitled, "Map of Supervisorial District Four," an enlargement of which can be viewed in either the Department of Information Services or Public Works.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Section 2.176.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.176.060 Fifth Supervisorial District:

The Fifth Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County depicted in the attached map entitled, "Map of Supervisorial District Five," an enlargement of which can be viewed in either the Department of Information Services or Public Works.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of passage

thereof.
