**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chief Elections Officer to render specified Election Services for the City of Menlo Park, City of Redwood City, City of San Bruno, City of San Mateo, City and County of San Francisco, San Mateo County Community College District, Sequoia Union High School District, Las Lomas Elementary School District, Portola Valley Elementary School District, and the Montara Sanitary District in conjunction with the Consolidated Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2001.

**Background:**

According to Elections Code §10002, the governing body of any city or district may request the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Elections Official to render specified services to the city or district relating to the conduct of an election. Subject to approval of the Board of Supervisors, these services shall be performed by the Chief Elections Officer.

**Discussion:**

In accordance with Education Code §§5304, 5322, and 15100, Government Code §1780, California Water Code §30830, Public Utilities Code §§11583 and 11641, and Elections Code §10002, resolutions were filed requesting the Chief Elections Officer to perform specified election services in conjunction with the Consolidated Election to be held on November 6, 2001.

It is in order for your Honorable Board to authorize the Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services for the above districts. We respectfully request that our recommendation be approved.

**Fiscal Impact:**

The City of Menlo Park, City of Redwood City, City of San Bruno, City of San Mateo, City and County of San Francisco, San Mateo County Community College District, Sequoia Union High School District, Las Lomas Elementary School District, Portola Valley Elementary School District, and the Montara Sanitary District will pay for the actual costs of services performed.

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California; that

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code and California Elections Code, the City Council of the City of Menlo Park adopted Ordinance No. 909 and Resolution No. 5335 calling for the submission of a bond measure to the voters of the City of Menlo Park; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code and California Elections Code, the City Council of the City of Redwood City adopted Resolution No. 14258 calling for the election of three City Council at the General Municipal Election in the City of Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code and California Elections Code, the City Council of the City of San Bruno adopted Resolution No. 2001-57 calling for the submission of an ordinance at the General Municipal Election in the City of San Bruno; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code and California Elections Code, the City Council of the City of San Mateo adopted Resolution No. 117 calling for the election of three City Council at the General Municipal Election in the City of San Mateo; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, the California Public Utilities Code, and California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City of and County of San

Francisco adopted a Resolution requesting that San Mateo County conduct an election within the boundaries of the City of Brisbane for the formation of a San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utilities District and election of its initial board members; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, California Education Code, and California Elections Code, the Governing Body of the San Mateo County Community College District adopted Resolution No. 01-19 calling for the submission of a bond measure to the voters of the San Mateo County Community College District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, California Education Code, and California Elections Code, the Governing Body of the Sequoia Union High School District adopted Resolution No. 1174 calling for the submission of a bond measure to the voters of the Sequoia Union High School District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, California Education Code, and California Elections Code, the Governing Body of the Las Lomas Elementary School District adopted Resolution No. 01-07-25(a) calling for the submission of a special tax measure to the voters of the Las Lomas Elementary School District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, California Education Code, and California Elections Code, the Governing Body of the Portola Valley Elementary School District adopted Resolution No. 10 calling for the submission of a bond measure to the voters of the Portola Valley Elementary School District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the California Government Code, California Water Code, and California Elections Code, the Governing Body of the Montara Sanitary District adopted Resolution Nos. 1209 and 1210 calling for the submission of a bond measure to the voters of the Montara Sanitary District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Elections Officer has been asked to perform certain services in conjunction with these elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing these election services to the Cities, School Districts, Special District, and the City and County of San Francisco; and

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of services and supplies provided by the Chief Elections Officer, the City of Menlo Park, City of Redwood City, City of San Bruno, City of San Mateo, City and County of San Francisco, San Mateo County Community College District, Sequoia Union High School District, Las Lomas Elementary School District, Portola Valley Elementary School District, and the Montara Sanitary District will pay for the actual costs of supplies and services performed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the President of this Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services for the November 6, 2001 Consolidated Election.
