This letter is to notify you that the terms of three (3) commissioners of the San Mateo Health Commission expired at noon on January 1, 2001. These three commissioners and the entities they represent are.

✓ Katherine McMillan	Representative of Senior and/or Minority Communities in San Mateo County
Frank Gibson	Representative of County Based Hospitals

Katy Rhoades and Katherine McMillan are eligible under the term limit provisions of the ordinance to be reappointed for another term if the Board of Supervisors should so decide. Frank Gibson was appointed on 12/20/94 to complete the term of a commissioner who resigned. Because he has served for just over six years as of 1/1/01, his appointment to another four year term would exceed the 10 year limit of serving on the commission. Therefore, Mr. Gibson is not eligible for reappointment to a new four year term.
