RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution adopting Plans and Specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for the Resurfacing of Clifford Avenue, from Scenic Drive to Belle Roche Avenue, Palomar Drive, from Belle Roche Avenue to Loma Court, South Palomar Drive and Loma Court, from Palomar Drive to the end of County maintained section, Acacia Lane, from Alameda de las Pulgas to the end of cul-de-sac and Woodhue Court, from Edgewood Road to the end of cul-de-sac, all as shown on the attached location maps (2).

Previous Board Action

- 1. Adopted minimum road standards and a priority list to be used in recommending road-resurfacing projects to your Board for the Palomar Park Area.
- 2. Authorized the Director of Public Works to proceed with the preparation of plans and specifications for resurfacing type projects on various County roads utilizing funds pursuant to Assembly Bill 2928 (AB2928).

Key Facts

- 1. Clifford Avenue, Palomar Drive, South Palomar Drive and Loma Court are the first streets on the priority list of roads to be resurfaced in the Palomar Park area.
- 2. Acacia Lane and Woodhue Court are two roads that were included in the list of roads to be resurfaced using AB2928 funds.

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Discussion

The proposed project, totaling approximately 1.63 miles in length, consists of the repair of failed pavement areas, the installation of pavement reinforcing fabric, the installation of asphalt berms where needed to control drainage, and the resurfacing of the roadways with asphalt concrete within the limits shown on the attached location maps (2).

This project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15301.C of the Public Resources Code (California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA]), and a Notice of Exemption has been filed with the County Clerk Recorder as provided by County guidelines.

Fiscal Impact

The estimated cost of construction is \$249,000, which is proposed to be financed with Road Funds and AB2928 Transportation Funds. There is no impact to the General Fund.

A form of resolution has been approved by County Counsel.





WHEREAS, Plans and Specifications have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the resurfacing of Clifford Avenue, from Scenic Drive to Belle Roche Avenue, Palomar Drive, from Belle Roche Avenue to Loma Court, South Palomar Drive and Loma Court, from Palomar Drive to the end of County maintained section, Acacia Lane, from Alameda de las Pulgas to the end of cul-de-sac and Woodhue Court, from Edgewood Road to the end of cul-de-sac in the San Carlos and Redwood City Area; and said Plans and Specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, a schedule of prevailing wage scales for each craft or type of workman needed to execute this contract in the locality in which said work is to be performed has been established by the Department of Industrial Relations and has been referred to in said Specifications:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Plans and Specifications dated March 9, 2001 for the aforesaid project, are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
- 2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received at the office of the County Manager / Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center (formerly 401 Marshall Street), Redwood City, California, until the hour of 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 3, 2001. Said bids will then be transmitted to the County Manager's office in said Hall of Justice and Records and be publicly opened and declared.

The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed proposals to be published for <u>two times</u> in the <u>San Mateo County</u>

<u>Times</u>, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

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
