### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the resolution which authorizes the Sheriff and Probation Departments to submit an Annual Training Plan Application to the State Board of Corrections for fiscal year 2001-2002.

#### BACKGROUND

In 1980, SB 94 became law establishing the Standards and Training for Corrections Programs for both law enforcement officers and probation officers.

The program is 100% state funded, including replacement costs for all institutional and selected probation officer functions.

Each year the Board of Corrections requires those interested counties to submit an annual training plan.

On October 16, 1980, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance number 02682 agreeing to the regulations required to participate in the SB 924 Program Each year since the Board has participated in the Program This will be the 21<sup>st</sup> year the County of San Mateo has participated in this program

#### DISCUSSION

A resolution from the Board of Supervisors is required to submit the plan. The plan must be submitted by April 15, 2001.

The County Counsel's office has reviewed the resolution.
