Mental Health services to PIP are provided by a full time mental health workers, who works collaboratively with the PIP DPOs to provide a variety of direct services and clinical coordination.
Preventing Repeat Offender Program (PROP)	Brisbane, Colma, Daly City, Pacifica and South San Francisco	A grant funded project administered under the California State Board of Corrections which is designed to identify minors at an early age who are at risk of becoming chronic juvenile offenders. The program provides intensive in home intervention and supervision to first time Juvenile court wards. To be considered for the program, a minor must be entering the system at age 15 ½ or younger.
