RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution adopting Plans and Specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for Slurry Sealing of Various Streets in the Ladera, Sequoia Tract, West Menlo, Menlo Oaks, Emerald Lakes Hills, Palomar Park, San Mateo Highlands and Daly City Areas.

Previous Board Action

Authorized the Director of Public Works to proceed with the preparation of plans and specifications for resurfacing type projects on various County roads utilizing funds available to the County pursuant to Assembly Bill 2928 (AB2928).

Key Facts

- 1. The proposed project is part of our overall program to preserve the County maintained road system.
- 2. We have coordinated the proposed work with the adjacent cities as the city limit line of some cities is down the center of the road to be slurried sealed.

Discussion

The proposed project, totaling approximately 4.5 miles in length, consists of pavement repair work and applying a slurry seal - a mixture of sand and an asphalt emulsion - over the existing pavement on the streets in the areas mentioned above and shown on the attached map. We have agreed to include the portions of the streets of the cities of Daly City and Menlo Park that are within the project limits and the cities have agreed to reimburse us for this work.

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The San Mateo County Planning Department has determined that this project is exempt from the requirements for preparation of an EIR under Section 15301(C) Class 1, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and we have filed a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk.

Fiscal Impact

The total estimated cost for this work is \$102,000. An appropriation was approved in the Road Fund for this work and we are proposing to finance the appropriation with AB2928 Transportation Funds to insure that these funds are expended by the deadline set by the State.

The work will be financed as follows:

City of Menlo Park	\$	735
City of Daly City	\$	1,160

Total \$102,000

There is no impact to the General Fund.

A form of resolution has been approved by County Counsel.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:


- 1. The Plans and Specifications dated April 6, 2001, for the aforesaid project, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
- 2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received by the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center (formerly 401 Marshall Street), Redwood City, California, San Mateo County, on or before 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 8, 2001, in said office in the Hall of Justice and Records, Redwood City, California. Said bids will then be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors' Chambers in said Hall of Justice and Records and be publicly opened and declared.

The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed proposals to be published for <u>two (2)</u> times in the <u>San Mateo County Times</u>, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
