Subject: Countywide Radio/Microwave Upgrade Project

Recommendation

Approve an ATR in the amount of \$4,220,612, transferring funds from the Radio Replacement Fund (\$1,400,000) and Non-Departmental Services (\$200,000) to the Capital Projects Fund, and reclassifying \$2,620,612 in the Capital Projects Fund from Fixed Assets – Structural Improvements to Fixed Assets – Equipment, for the purpose of paying Motorola Incorporated the first installment for two contracts to design and install Countywide radio/microwave systems.

Background/Discussion

On March 27, 2001 this Board authorized the County Manager to enter into a contract with Motorola Incorporated in the amount of \$10,740,000 to design, build and install a trunked radio system for County radio communication users. Prior to that, the Emergency Services Council Joint Powers Authority (ESC JPA) entered into an agreement with Motorola in the amount of \$10,440,000 to design and install two ESC JPA systems – the microwave system and the mutual aid radio system. The Employee and Public Services Department has been designated the lead agency for both projects and is administrating the contracts with Motorola.

Fiscal Impact

The first installment of \$4.2 million, which covers both contracts, is due to Motorola by April 27, 2001. Funds are currently located in three locations, the Capital Projects Fund (\$2.6 million), the Radio Replacement Fund (\$1,400,000) and Non-Departmental Services (\$200,000). The ATR will increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund from \$2.6 million to \$4.2 million with reimbursement coming from the other two sources. The only impact on the General Fund will be the \$200,000 provided by Non-Departmental Services, which will be reimbursed after debt service financing has been realized in the Fall. The Project Manager will ensure that funds provided for each of the contracts are clearly delineated between the County and the ESC JPA
