SUBJECT Acceptance of the Susan G Komen Breast Cancer Foundation and Kristi Yamaguchi's Always Dream Foundation Grant

RECOMMENDATION

- 1 Adopt a Resolution authorizing the President of the Board to accept a Susan G Komen Breast Cancer Foundation and Kristi Yamaguchi's Always Dream Foundation Grant in the amount of \$90,020
- 2 Approve an Appropriation Transfer Request (ATR) in the amount of \$90,020

Background and Discussion

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Since its founding in 1988, the San Francisco Bay Area Affiliate of the Susan G Komen Breast Cancer Foundation has awarded over \$1 million in grants to provide mammography screening and diagnostic services for uninsured women In 1998, the Komen Affiliate formed a task force to determine how best to fulfill its commitment to promoting early detection of breast cancer among low-income women A special grant was created through the Komen Foundation and the Kristi Yamaguchi Always Dream Foundation to support mammography services for low income women Nine counties in the Bay Area region could apply for these funds

On average, fourteen clients are seen in mammography each day In order to operate an FDA certified mammography unit, the department must provide reporting of patient outcomes and documentation of patient follow-up and care The current SMS software used in the mammography unit is not capable of tracking and reporting on patient care and outcomes The staff on the unit have had to track and report this patient information manually using physician and pathology reports, hand-written log books, and letter notification of follow-up services to patients The funding from this grant will allow the unit to purchase an upgraded SMS software system that has both reporting and tracking capabilities integrated with the registration process

This mammography module will provide automated tracking and monitoring of mammography results to insure patient follow-up and care In addition, this software will provide a database of all mammography patients, including mammography history, exam findings and patient care and outcomes.

The Information Services Department has been involved in the selection process of the new SMS software to ensure system integration and compatibility

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Fiscal Impact

The total cost of the one-time license fee, installation fees, and support for the mammography module is \$139,535 San Mateo County Hospital and Clinics was awarded \$90,020 by the Komen Foundation This amount will be used to pay for the installation and support fees for the mammography module The one-time license fee in the amount of \$49,515 will be paid for through savings in the current Radiology Department operating budget The Equipment Maintenance (account no 5419) budgeted amount has a projected savings of \$51,000 This was created because of delays in equipment being delivered and installed

The Susan G Komen Foundation grant period is January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001 No staff positions are funded through this grant

GRANT CONTRACT

GRANTEE: San Mateo County General Hospitals and Clinics

TITLE OF PROJECT: Mammography Software

PROJECT DIRECTOR: Gayle Hawkins

GRANT PERIOD: January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

The Bay Area Affiliate of The Susan G Komen Breast Cancer Foundation ("Komen") does hereby grant **San Mateo County General Hospitals and Clinics** ("Grantee") funds in the amount of **\$90,020** ("Grant Funds") subject to the following terms and conditions

1 Grant Funds are to be applied as set forth in the budget ("Budget") in Grantee's grant application to Komen received by Komen on or before the application deadline of August 15, 2000

2 Grant Funds must be expended as set forth in the Budget and no changes or modifications to the Budget or to the project as described in the Grant Application may be made without the prior written approval of Komen

3 Grantee shall return to Komen any and all Grant Funds upon the occurrence of any one or more of the following events

a The Grant Funds cannot be expended in accordance with the Budget,

b The breast cancer project described in the grant proposal changes and any or all of these changes are not approved by Komen,

c Grantee does not comply, in the determination of Komen's Grants Committee and its Board of Directors with the terms of this contract and its Attachment, or

d Grantee loses its United States Internal Revenue Service tax-exempt status

4 Grant Funds shall be payable in one installment of **\$90,020**

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- 5 Grantee shall submit to Komen the following.
 - a Mid-term progress report on June 30, 2001 and shall include, but not be limited to -progress of project toward meeting objectives outlined in Grant Application, -number of people served,

-notice or receipt of other sources of support for this project,

-copy or examples of all materials produced,

-accounting of the Grant Funds expended

b Copies of all news releases, articles and any other materials, pictures, etc which may develop in connection with this grant award These copies should be furnished prior to publication, or as soon thereafter as possible

c By January 31, 2002, a final report according to Attachment A of this contract The final report should include an accounting of the Grant Funds expended during the term of this contract and be signed by the chief financial officer of the Grantee organization

6 Komen may release information regarding this grant as well as the progress reports and final report to the general public and news media Grantee represents to Komen that it has the authority to grant Komen the right to publish the works and any photographs relating to this project

7 Grantee will make every effort to release information regarding this grant to the public and news media

8 Grantee agrees to acknowledge Komen as a funding source on all publications related to this grant award Use of the Komen cameo logo must be approved by the Komen affiliate before such use

9 This grant is accepted by Grantee with the understanding that Komen is not obligated to provide additional support

10 Grantee will cooperate with Komen in supplying additional information or in complying with any procedures which might be required by any governmental agency in order for Komen to establish that it has observed all requirements of the law with respect to this grant

11 All officers and individuals executing this agreement certify and warrant that they have the capacity and have been duly authorized to execute this contract on behalf of the entities so indicated and that no additional authorization or approval is required

12 Both parties agree that this contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the

State of California and that venue shall lie in the District Courts of San Francisco County, for the purpose of any lawsuit regarding this contract

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This grant is expressly conditional upon Grantee's acceptance of the terms and conditions set forth above and in Attachment A The signature on this contract by an authorized representative of San Mateo County General Hospitals and Clinics represents San Mateo County General Hospitals and Clinics's acceptance of this award and agreement to comply with all of the above terms and conditions

ATTACHMENT A

The mid-term report (due June 30, 2001) and the final report (due January 31, 2002) must include the following information

- a. Details of the purchase, installment, training on and use of software purchased with these funds
- b Definition and explanation of progress made toward reaching the specific objectives outlined in the original grant application and this Attachment
- c Short summary evaluating how the funding received from the Komen Foundation impacted this project and the future plans for the project.
- d Has Komen funding allowed you to meet criteria in order to apply to, or be more competitively reviewed by, other agencies for funding? If so, please include a listing of those grants received (i e NIH, ACS, etc.)
- e The mid-term report must be accompanied by an accounting of the Grant Funds used to date by category and with a comparison to the budget submitted in the grant application. The final report must be accompanied by a comprehensive accounting of the grant funds used for the entire term of the grant period.

A liaison from the Komen Grants Committee will be appointed to be a contact with the San Mateo County General Hospitals and Clinics on this project Questions, issues, and concerns regarding the project, the contract, or Komen's expectations should be brought to the attention of the liaison at the earliest possible time.
