#### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution of Intention setting a time and place for a public hearing to consider the proposed annexation of the Lands of Kellogg to the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District

#### **Previous Board Action**

Entered into an agreement with the Town of Woodside to provide for the transport and the treatment of sewage from the Town's Redwood Creek Main Trunk and Glens Collection System Assessment District

#### **Key Facts**

- The property to be annexed is within the Assessment District, but is not within the current boundaries of the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District (District)
- The Agreement requires the Town of Woodside to approve annexations of property in the Town into the District
- 3 The Town has consented to the proposed annexation
- A public hearing to consider an annexation to the District is required pursuant to Section 5838 et seq of the Street and Highways Code

#### **Discussion**

Mr and Mrs Harry W Kellogg Jr, whose property is at 215 Ridgeway Road and identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 069-141-030, have requested their property be annexed to the District for the purpose of receiving sewer services. The Town of Woodside has adopted Resolution No 2001-6257 consenting to the proposed annexation

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of said Board to annex the territory in the Town of Woodside to the FAIR OAKS SEWER

MAINTENANCE DISTRICT (District), which territory is described in Exhibit A hereto attached and made a part hereof by reference

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on Tuesday, the <u>22<sup>nd</sup></u> day of <u>May</u>, 2001, at the hour of <u>9:30 a.m.</u> o clock, at the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, in the Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center (formerly 401 Marshall Street), Redwood City, California, are hereby fixed as the date, time and place when and where all persons having any objection to the annexation of said territory to said District may be heard

The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of said County, pursuant to Section 5838 et seq of the Streets and Highway Code, shall cause a copy of Exhibit B to this Resolution headed by the words "NOTICE OF HEARING", to be published once a week for two successive weeks in the San Mateo County Times, a newspaper of general circulation, circulated in said District, and

in the territory proposed to be annexed, deemed by this Board to be most likely to give notice of hearing to all the inhabitants of each

Copies of this Resolution with the heading of "NOTICE OF HEARING" in letters not less than one inch in height shall also be posted in three conspicuous places within the maintenance district to which such territory is proposed to be annexed, and three conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed, not less than ten days prior to the day set for the hearing



# PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF THE LANDS OF KELLOGG TO THE FAIR OAKS SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT (215 RIDGEWAY ROAD)

Lot 45 and a portion of Ridgeway Road, as said Lot, and Road are shown on the map entitled "Tract No 579, Woodside Hills, Unit No 2" filed in the Office of the Recorder of the County of San Mateo, State of California, on July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1947 in Book 27 of maps at Pages 21, 22, 23 and 24, and more particularly described as follows

Beginning at the most southerly corner of said Lot 45, said point also being an angle point in the boundaries of the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District as established by Res #041346 passed and adopted on August 19, 1980, Thence from said Point of Beginning North 38° 19' 23" East along the southeasterly line of said Lot and along said District boundaries, 165 14 feet to an angle point in the District boundaries as established by Res #55721, passed and adopted on December 17, 1991 said point also being the southwesterly corner of Lot 44 as shown on said map, Thence continuing along said District boundaries and the northeasterly line of said Lot North 5° 46' 07" East 251 70 feet to a point in the southerly line of said Ridgeway Road, Thence northeasterly, leaving said District boundaries along the northeasterly prolongation of the northwesterly line of said Lot, 50 feet more or less to a point in the northerly line of said Ridgeway Road. Thence northwesterly along said northerly line 70 feet more or less to the southeasterly corner of Lot 36 as shown on said map and an angle in the boundary of the Fair Oaks Sewer Maintenance District as established by Res #52135 passed and adopted on December 13, 1988, Thence continuing northwesterly along said northerly line and District boundary 110 feet more or less to the intersection thereof with the northeasterly prolongation of the westerly line of said Lot 45. Thence leaving said northerly line and District boundary southwesterly along said prolongation and westerly line South 17° 47' 23" West 328 feet more or less to the southwesterly corner of said Lot. Thence South 48° 53' 45" East 199 95 feet to the Point of Beginning
