*WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that GWEN NASH-MALLORY is retiring after 37 years of dedicated service from the San Mateo County Probation Department; and*

*WHEREAS, on May 11, 1964, GWEN NASH-MALLORY began her illustrious career with the San Mateo County Probation Department as a Juvenile Group Supervisor I, working part-time in the Juvenile Hall Detention Center and because of her knowledge, skills and leadership, Gwen was promoted to Assistant Probation Officer I, Assistant Probation Officer II and Assistant Probation Officer III, in the Juvenile Division; and*

*WHEREAS, in 1979, GWEN NASH-MALLORY transferred to the Family Court Services Division in the Probation Department; and*

*WHEREAS, in March, 1995 GWEN NASH-MALLORY worked for the Victim and Witness Program in the South San Francisco Adult Division. With her years of service to the Probation Department, Gwen was promoted to Senior Deputy Probation Officer in September, 1996. Gwen transferred to the East Palo Alto office where she will retire; and*

*WHEREAS, GWEN NASH-MALLORY is one of the original founders of "Black Women In County Government," and is a member of "Women in Government;" and*

*WHEREAS, GWEN NASH-MALLORY will be retiring to Galt, California, where she has purchased a home.*
