## SUBJECT: Emerald Lake Hills Resurfacing Project – Redwood City Area (Project No. R5V01-F-36 [369])

## RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution awarding and authorizing execution of a contract for the Emerald Lake Hills Resurfacing Project.

### **Previous Board Action**

Adopted Resolution No. 64334 on March 27, 2001, adopting Plans and Specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for the above referenced project.

### Discussion

On April 17, 2001, bids were accepted for this project and subsequently referred to this office for checking and recommendation. The bids have been checked and the bid of:

## Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. 128 South Maple Avenue South San Francisco, CA 94080

at \$166,226 was the lowest bid received The Engineer's estimate was \$200,000. A summary of the bids received is as follows

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We have reviewed the contract documents and have determined the Affirmative Action Program submitted by **Interstate Grading and Paving**, **Inc.** is in accordance with the current Affirmative Action Guidelines

## **Fiscal Impact**

The total overall estimated cost of this project, including construction and contingencies is \$183,000 which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency as the work is bid on a unit price basis (i.e., ton of asphalt placed, square yard of pavement fabric, etc.). The contingency is used to pay the contractor for any additional material placed as the actual tonnage used depends on the unit weight of the asphalt and the tolerances for the actual thickness of the pavement placed

The work is proposed to be financed with Road Funds made available by the State pursuant to AB 2928.

There is no impact to the General Fund

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## Resolution Awarding and Authorizing Execution of a Contract for the Emerald Lake Hills Resurfacing Project – Emerald Lake Hills -Redwood City Area

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on March 27, 2001, adopt Resolution

No. 64334, which Resolution adopted the Plans and approved the Specifications, determined the

prevailing wage scales and called for sealed proposals for the Emerald Lake Hills Resurfacing

Project; and

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WHEREAS, the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on April 17, 2001, at

2 00 p m, open and examine all sealed proposals that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Resolution No 64334, and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said sealed proposals to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said proposals and the analysis thereof, and WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was submitted by Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc., in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Six and No/100 Dollars (\$166,226.00) based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done

#### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows

 That it is to the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the contract for the Emerald Lake Hills Resurfacing Project – Emerald Lake Hills – Redwood City Area to

#### Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. 128 South Maple Avenue South San Francisco, CA 94080

2. That the County of San Mateo shall enter into a written contract with Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. for the doing of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications therefore adopted and approved by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, said Plans and Specifications being on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo

3. That the President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, to enter into said written contract with **Interstate Grading and Paving**, **Inc** for the doing of said work, as hereinbefore mentioned and to receive and approve the Faithful Performance Surety Bond and the Labor and Material Surety Bond required to be posted by the said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith. 4. That all payments to the Contractor be in accordance with the Plans, Specifications, and other contract documents, based on the Director of Public Works written estimates of work actually done.

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That, Paragraph 4 above notwithstanding, aggregate payments to
Contractor shall not exceed the sum of One Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand and No/100
Dollars (\$183,000.00) without this Board's approval

6. That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written contract

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
