THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA HONORING

THE SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT/COMMUNITY ROUNDTABLE on its 20TH ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS the San Francisco International Airport, the ninth busiest airport in the world is owned and operated by the City and County of San Francisco and is located entirely within San Mateo County, and

WHEREAS from 1978 to 1980, a Joint Land Use Study was conducted by the Counties of San Francisco and San Mateo to address several issues associated with the operation of San Francisco International Airport including aircraft noise impacts, and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco International Aurport/Community Roundtable was formed in 1981 to monitor the implementation of the recommendations of the Joint Land Use Study and to provide access to local elected officials Airport management Federal Aviation Administration staff and airline representatives to address neighborhood and community noise impacts from aircraft operations at San Francisco International Airport and

WHEREAS the County of San Mateo was a founding member of the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable and

WHEREAS the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable held its first meeting on June 3 1981 and continues to meet on a monthly basis to provide a valuable public forum and

WHEREAS the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable monitors a performancebased aircraft noise mitigation program as implemented by Airport staff interprets community concerns and attempts to achieve additional noise mitigation through a cooperative sharing of authority brought forth by the aviation industry the Federal Aviation Administration Airport management and local government officials and

WHEREAS, largely due to the ongoing efforts of the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable, the number of dwelling units within the state and federal 65 dB CNEL aircraft noise impact threshold level has been reduced from approximately 15,400 dwelling units in 1980 to approximately 1,360 in 2000 and

WHEREAS the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable is recognized at the state and national levels as a model for intergovermental cooperation, and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable will celebrate its 20^{tl} anniversary on June 6 2001,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors commends and congratulates the San Francisco International Airport/Community Roundtable on its 20^d Anniversary for its longevity its outstanding efforts to address the complicated issues of aircraft noise impacts and its overall goal of improving the quality of life for thousands of citizens in San Mateo County
