SUBJECT: Chip or Cape Sealing of Various Roads - County Wide

## RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution adopting plans and specifications, determining prevailing wage scales and calling for sealed proposals for the Chip or Cape Sealing of the various roads shown on the attached maps.

## **Previous Board Action**

Adopted a resolution authorizing the Director of Public Works to proceed with the preparation of plans and specifications for resurfacing type projects on various County roads utilizing funds pursuant to Assembly Bill 2928 (AB2928)

#### **Key Facts**

The proposed project is part of our overall program to preserve the County maintained road system.

#### **Discussion**

The proposed Project, totaling approximately 13.06 miles in length, consists of placement of a cape seal (a chip seal - a combination of aggregate and an asphaltic emulsion - and a slurry seal - a combination of sand and asphaltic emulsion) over the existing pavement on Cloverdale Road; and a chip seal over the existing pavement on various roads in the Skyline Area between Highway 92 and Highway 84, and in the La Honda area off of Highway 84. Pavement repairs to the various roads will be done prior to the placement of the chip or cape seal.

The County's Planning Division has reviewed the project and determined that it is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and a notice of exemption has been filed with the County Clerk pursuant to Section 15302, Class 2 of CEQA.

This project has also been determined by the Planning Division to be exempt from the requirement for a Coastal Development Permit and they have certified Exemption Number 2001-0065

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#### **Fiscal Impact**

The estimated total cost for construction is \$465,000 This construction has been budgeted in the 2000-01 Road Fund Budget and is proposed to be financed with AB2928 Funds.

There is no impact to the General Fund.

A form of resolution has been approved by County Counsel.



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Resolution Adopting Plans and Specifications, Determining Prevailing Wage Scales and Calling for Sealed Proposals for the Chip or Cape Sealing of Various Roads in San Mateo County

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Plans and Specifications have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Chip or Cape Sealing of various roads in San Mateo County as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto made a part hereof Said Plans and Specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works, and presented to this Board for its approval, and this Board has considered same, and

WHEREAS, a schedule of prevailing wages for each craft or type of workman needed to execute this contract in the locality in which said work is to be performed has been established by the Department of Industrial Relations and has been referred to in said Specification.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows

1. The Plans and Specifications dated May 18, 2001 for the aforesaid project, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performed the work under a contract for said improvements

2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.

3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received by the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, on or before <u>2:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 12, 2001</u>, in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices in the Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California. Said bids will then be publicly opened and declared in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices for the following project in accordance with specifications therefor and to which special reference is made as follows:

## CHIP OR CAPE SEALING OF VARIOUS ROADS – COUNTY WIDE, MORE SPECIFICALLY -BIG TREE WAY, BLAKEWOOD WAY, CHAPMAN ROAD, CLOVERDALE ROAD, COMSTOCK ROAD, COUNTY ROAD, CUESTA REAL, ELK TREE ROAD, FOREST VIEW ROAD, HARKINS ROAD, OLD LA HONDA ROAD, RIDGE ROAD, SEQUOIA WAY, SKY L'ONDA DRIVE, SKYLINE DRIVE, SWETT ROAD, WARE ROAD. TOTAL PROJECT APPROXIMATELY 13.06 MILES IN LENGTH WITH APPURTENANT WORK THERETO.

inviting sealed proposals to be published for  $\underline{\text{two}(2) \text{ times}}$  in the <u>San Mateo County Times</u>, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a
