RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution awarding and authorizing execution of a Contract with El Camino Paving, Inc, for the resurfacing of Gilman, Larchmont, and Mac Arthur Drives

Previous Board Action

Approved Plans and Specifications, determined prevailing wage scales and called for sealed proposals for the above-mentioned project

Discussion

On Tuesday, May 8, 2001, bids were accepted for this project and subsequently referred to this office for checking and recommendation The bids have been checked and the bid of

at \$224,003.90 was the lowest bid received

The Engineer s estimate was \$234,000 A summary of the bids received is as follows

Fiscal Impact

The total estimated construction cost of the project is \$247,000 which includes a 10% contingency as the work is bid on a unit price basis(i e ton of asphalt placed, square yard of pavement fabric, etc) The contingency is used to pay the contractor for any additional material placed as the actual tonnage used depends on the unit weight of the asphalt and the tolerances for the actual thickness of the pavement placed Funds have been appropriated in the Road Fund to finance this work

There is no impact to the General Fund

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**Resolution Awarding and Authorizing Execution
of a Contract for the
Resurfacing of Gilman, Larchmont,
and Mac Arthur Drives in the Broadmoor Village Area
(County Roads No. 158, 131, and 132 respectively)**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on April 10, 2001, adopt Resolution No. 64368, which adopted the Plans and approved the Specifications, determined the prevailing wage scales and called for sealed proposals for the Resurfacing Project of Gilman, Larchmont, and Mac Arthur Drives in the Broadmoor Village Area (County Roads No 158, 131, and 132); and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on May 8, 2001, open and examine all sealed proposals that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Resolution No 64368, and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said sealed proposals to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said sealed proposals and the analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, El Camino Paving, Inc , submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of **Two Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand, Three Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$224,003.90)** based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows

1. That it is in the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the contract for the resurfacing of Gilman, Larchmont, and Mac Arthur Drives in the Broadmoor Village Area (County Roads No 158, 131, and 132) to the lowest bidder

2. That the County of San Mateo shall enter into a written contract with El Camino Paving, Inc for the doing of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications therefor adopted and approved by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, said Plans and Specifications being on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo

3. That the President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, to enter into said written contract with El Camino Paving, Inc., for doing of said work, as hereinbefore mentioned and to receive and approve the Faithful Performance Surety Bond and the Labor and Material Surety Bond required to be posted by the said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith

4. That all payments to the Contractor be in accordance with the Plans, Specifications, and other contract documents, based on the Director of Public Works' written estimates of work actually done

5. That, Paragraph 4 above notwithstanding, aggregate payments to Contractor shall not exceed the sum of **Two Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$247,000.00)** without this Board's prior approval

6. That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written contract

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
