SUBJECT: Resurfacing of Portions of Airport Street near Pillar Point Harbor and Pescadero Creek Road in the Loma Mar Area (Project No. R6W01, F-116[200A])

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution adopting Plans and Specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for the Resurfacing of Portions of Airport Street and Pescadero Creek Road.

Previous Board Action

Authorized the Director of Public Works to:

- 1. Proceed with the preparation of plans and specifications for resurfacing type projects on various County roads utilizing funds available to the County pursuant to Assembly Bill 2928 (AB2928).
- 2. Execute agreements with utility companies and special districts for utility type work less than \$25,000 proposed to be done in conjunction with County road projects.

Key Facts

The proposed project is part of our overall program to preserve the County maintained road system.

The Montara Sanitary District and the Coastside County Water District have requested that their facilities be adjusted to grade by the County's contractor, in conjunction with the County's proposed resurfacing project.

Discussion

The proposed project, totaling approximately 2.1 miles in length, consists of pavement repair work, installation of pavement reinforcing fabric, and resurfacing of Airport Street between Harvard Avenue and the Grande Del Mar Mobile Home Park and Pescadero Creek Road between the two Wurr Road intersections.

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The San Mateo County Planning Department has determined that this project qualifies for exemptions from the filing of a Coastal Development Permit and the requirements for the preparation of an EIR under Section 15301(C) Class 1, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and we have filed a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk.

Fiscal Impact

The total estimated cost for this work is \$440,000. An appropriation was approved in the Road Fund for this work, and we are proposing to finance the appropriation with AB2928 Transportation Funds to insure that these funds are expended by the deadline set by the State.

The work will be financed as follows:

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Plans and Specifications have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Resurfacing of Portions of Airport Street near Pillar Point Harbor and Pescadero Creek Road in the Loma Mar Area, and said Plans and Specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, a schedule of prevailing wage scales for each craft or type of workman needed to execute this contract in the locality in which said work is to be performed has been established by the Department of Industrial Relations and has been referred to in said Specifications:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Plans and Specifications dated June 15, 2001, for the aforesaid project, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
- 2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received by the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, on or before 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 17, 2001, in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices in the Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California. Said bids will then be publicly opened and declared in the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' offices.

The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed proposals to be published for <u>two (2)</u> times in the <u>San Mateo County Times</u>, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

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
