#### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution awarding and authorizing execution of a contract for the reconstruction of Beresford Avenue and Sequoia Avenue between West Selby Lane and Stockbridge Avenue, and the resurfacing of a portion of Beresford Avenue.

## **Previous Board Action**

Adopted Resolution No. 64511 on June 5, 2001, adopting Plans and Specifications, determining prevailing wage scales, and calling for sealed proposals for the reconstruction of Beresford Avenue and Sequoia Avenue and the resurfacing of a portion of Beresford Avenue.

#### Discussion

On June 26, 2001, bids were accepted for this project and subsequently referred to this office for checking and recommendation. The bids have been checked and the bid of:

# Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. 128 So. Maple Avenue South San Francisco, CA 94080

at \$417,741 was the lowest bid received. The Engineer's estimate was \$420,000. A summary of the bids received is as follows:

1. Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc.	\$ 417,741
2. O'Grady Paving, Inc.	\$ 496,395
3. C. F. Archibald Paving Inc.	\$ 500,229

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We have reviewed the contract documents and have determined that the affirmative action program of Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. is in accordance with the current Affirmative Action Guidelines.

### **Fiscal Impact**

The total estimated cost for construction and contingencies is \$460,000. The work is proposed to be financed with Road Funds and Road Mitigation Fees.

There is no impact to the General Fund.

A form of resolution has been approved by County Counsel.

Resolution Awarding and Authorizing Execution of a Contract for the Reconstruction of Beresford Avenue and Sequoia Avenue between West Selby Lane and Stockbridge Avenue in the Redwood City Area (Project No. R6J01, F-149 [5Ub])

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on June 5, 2001, adopt Resolution

No. 64511, which Resolution adopted the Plans and approved the Specifications, determined the prevailing wage scales and called for sealed proposals for the reconstruction of Beresford Avenue and Sequoia Avenue between West Selby Lane and Stockbridge Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on June 26, 2001, open and examine all sealed proposals that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Resolution No. 64511; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said sealed proposals to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said sealed proposals and the analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was submitted by Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc., in the amount of Four Hundred Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred Forty

One and no/100 Dollars (\$417,741.00) based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1.. That it is to the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the contract for the reconstruction of Beresford Avenue and Sequoia Avenue to:

Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. 128 So. Maple Avenue South San Francisco, CA 94080

- 2. That the County of San Mateo shall enter into a written contract with Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. for the doing of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications therefore adopted and approved by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, said Plans and Specifications being on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
- 3. That the President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, to enter into said written contract with Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc. for doing of said work, as hereinbefore mentioned and to receive and approve the Faithful Performance Surety Bond and the Labor and Material Surety Bond required to be posted by the said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith.
- 4. That all payments to the Contractor be in accordance with the Plans,

  Specifications, and other contract documents, based on the Director of Public Works' written estimates of work actually done.

- 5. That, Paragraph 4 above notwithstanding, aggregate payments to Contractor shall not exceed the sum of Four Hundred Sixty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$460,000.00) without this Board's prior approval.
- 6. That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written contract.

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
