SUBJECT: Screener Card Applications for the Federal Surplus Property Depot

Recommendation

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the President of the Board to execute a State Resolution Form that authorizes the Sheriff's Office to apply for the federal surplus screener cards.

Background

The State of California's Department of General Services Office of Surplus Property administers a program for the federal government to sell or donate federal surplus property from all branches of the Armed Forces installations that have closed or have been reduced in size. Occasionally specific Federal military installations located throughout the world can close which creates a large volume of surplus items and equipment that are up for auction or sale at a greatly reduced price.

In July 1996, your Board approved a resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Office to apply for the federal surplus screener cards. The Sheriff's Office has occasion to search for specific federal surplus law enforcement equipment, which can save taxpayer dollars. The Sheriff's Office acquired 15 surplus body armor vest at \$20 each for a total cost of \$300. Normally these vests can cost up to \$350 apiece from wholesale vendors.

Discussion

The Sheriff's Office has requested authorization to apply for federal screening cards that allows the cardholder to screen federal surplus property depots. The State of California's Department of General Services requires that all applicants applying for the federal surplus screener's card must have their Governing Board (Board of Supervisors) adopt the State's Resolution Form, completed in the State's format. ASSURANCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH GSA REGULATIONS UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964, SCTION 606 OF TITLE VI OF THE FEDERAL PROPERTY AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES ACT OF 1949, AS AMENDED, SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATIN ACT OF 1973, AS AMENDED, TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION AMENDEMENTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED AND SECTION 303 OF THE AGE DISCRIMINATION ACT OF 1975.

HEREBY AGREES THAT the program for or in connection with which any property is donated to the donee will be conducted in compliance with, and the donee will comply with and will require any other person (any legal entity) who through contractual or other arrangements with the donee is authorized to provide services or benefits under said program to comply with, all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations of the General Services Administration (41 CRF 101-6.2) issued under the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 606 of Title VI of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, as amended, and Section 303 of the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, to the end that no person in the United States shall on the ground of race, color, national origin, sex, or age, or that no otherwise qualified handicapped person shall solely by reason of the handicap, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the donee received Federal assistance from the General Services Administration; and HEREBY GIVES ASSURANCE THAT it will immediately take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement.

The donee further agrees that this agreement shall be subject in all respects to the provisions of said regulations; that this agreement shall obligate the donee for the period during which it retains ownership or possession of any such property; that the United States shall have the right to seek judicial enforcement of this agreement; and, this agreement shall be binding upon any successor in interest of the donee and the word "donee" as used herein includes any such successor in interest.
