SUBJECT: **Cost Reimbursement Agreement – Rehabilitation of Route 82 (El Camino Real) – Mission Road to A Street – Colma Area**

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution authorizing the President of the Board to execute Program Supplement Agreement No. M005 to Administering Agency - State Agreement No. 04-5935 which provides for the partial cost reimbursement for pavement rehabilitation on portions of El Camino Real (Route 82) over flood control improvements to be constructed in the Route 82 right-of-way.

Previous Board Action

Entered into cooperative agreement with the State of California Department of Transportation for cost sharing in conjunction with the construction of flood control improvements in Route 82, in the Colma Area.

Key Facts

1. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) administers federal grants on behalf of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
2. A Program Supplement Agreement is required in order for the County to receive federal funds made available through the FHWA to finance a portion of the proposed roadway rehabilitation work.

Discussion

Flood control improvements are scheduled for construction in El Camino Real through the Town of Colma and the roadway pavement in the area is proposed to be repaired as part of the Flood Control project. Colma applied and qualified for federal funding for the rehabilitation work and subsequently transferred funding sponsorship to San Mateo County in order to consolidate and simplify fund disbursements and account auditing procedures. A condition of receiving the federal funding is the execution of the Program Supplement Agreement.

Fiscal Impact

The estimated cost of pavement work over the flood control improvements is \$999,000, which will initially be financed with Flood Control District Funds that have been appropriated for the work. The District will be reimbursed in the amount of \$810,000 if your Board authorizes execution of the Program Supplement Agreement.

There is no impact to the General Fund.

A form of resolution and agreement has been approved by County Counsel.

SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

1. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY will reimburse the State for their share of costs for work requested to be performed by the State.
2. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY agrees that payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Authorization/Agreement or Amendment/Modification (E-76) and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid letter or its modification as prepared by the Office of Project Implementation, Local Assistance Program.
3. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY will advertise, award and administer this project in accordance with the current Local Assistance Procedures Manual.
4. Award information shall be submitted by the ADMINISTERING AGENCY to the District Local Assistance Engineer immediately after the award. Failure to do so will cause delay in processing the invoices for the construction phase. Please refer to Section 15.7 "Award Package" of the Local Assistance Procedures Manual.
5. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY is required to have an audit in accordance with the Single Audit Act and OMB A-133, if it receives \$300,000 or more in federal funds in a single fiscal year. The federal funds received under this project are a part of the Catalogue of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) 20.205, Highway Planning and Research. OMB A-133 superceded OMB A-128 in 1996. Reference to OMB A-128 in Master Agreement (if any) is superceded by this covenant.
6. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article III MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be the responsibility of the ADMINISTERING AGENCY and shall be performed at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
