Continuation of Contracts

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Controller to continue payments on contracts from July 1, 2001 through September 30, 2001.

Summary

On June 26, 2001 your Board approved resolution no. 64587 authorizing the Controller to continue payments through September 30, 2001 on Health Services contracts that expire on or before June 30, 2001. Contracts with Veterans Affairs Palo Alto Health Care System, Mt. Diablo Medical Pavilion and Health Management Systems (HMS) are to be incorporated into the list of contracts submitted.

The contracts with Veterans Affairs (VA) were not included in the Continuing Resolution because VA management promised that they would have the signed documents to Health Services by the middle of June. The first contract is for the provision of space to locate and operate the Willow Clinic. The amount of this contract is \$529,293. The second contract with the VA is for the provision of space for the operation of the Methadone Treatment Program. The amount of this contract is \$158,665. The VA was delayed in determining their cost allocation and were not able to inform us of our rent charges for both clinics for the coming year. The new contract currently being developed between Health Services and the VA consolidates the charges for the Willow Clinic and Methadone Treatment Program into one contract.

The contract with Mount Diablo Medical Pavilion is for the provision of psychiatric inpatient hospital services to children and adolescents. Health Services contracts with other acute care hospitals and free-standing psychiatric hospitals to provide this service. Collectively, all contracts for these psychiatric services are not to exceed \$1,300,000.

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The contract with Health Management Systems, Inc. (HMS) is for the provision of computer software and software maintenance for the Global patient services registration and billing system. Until such time as all of the Public Health data, including the Public Health Lab is moved to the Core system, Health Services must continue to contract with HMS to ensure proper operation of the system, for needed maintenance and support. This amount of this contract is \$325,000.

To ensure continued provision of services until new contracts can be negotiated and developed, it is necessary to authorize the Controller to continue to make payments to these contractors at the existing rates through September 30, 2001. This resolution allows contractors to meet their commitments in a timely fashion and will allow the divisions time needed to complete negotiations. This resolution requires that all terms and conditions of the existing agreements be met.

Fiscal Impact

Funds for the annual cost of all contracts have been included in the Health Services' 2001-02 recommended budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board authorizes the Controller to continue payments through September 30, 2001, on said Agreements for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, subject to the contractors' continued compliance with all terms and conditions of its most recent and previous agreement with the County with the exception of the fiscal terms provisions. Said payments are to be in the amounts authorized by the Director of Health Services.
