SUBJECT: 2001 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Office to apply for the 2001 Local Law Enforcement Block grant funds and allow the County Manager to enter into a written contract with the Department of Justice in the amount of \$24,117.

BACKGROUND

Beginning in FY 1996/97, Congress has annually approved the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program (LLEBG). This program entitles each selected criminal justice agency to a specified amount of funding, to be used for various categories of equipment or services. Award amounts vary year-to-year by agency, based on the LLEBG formula. This year San Mateo County's award is \$24,117 with a local hard match requirement of \$2,680. Two mandatory hearings must be held before completing the LLEBG application and requesting the draw down of funds; a Public Hearing is scheduled for July 31, 2001 before the Board of Supervisors and the Advisory Board hearing is scheduled for August 29, 2001.

DISCUSSION & FISCAL IMPACT

The Department of Justice LLEBG Program provides grant funds directly to local law enforcement agencies. The agencies can use these funds in any of seven broad-based purpose areas. However, funds cannot be used to purchase, lease, rent or acquire vehicles. Further, funding must be used to increase the amount of funds that would be available otherwise from State and local sources (the "non-supplantation" requirement).

For FY 2001/02, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded \$24,117 which we have identified in our budget for the purchase of replacement laptops and various technology devices which will assist with the service of felony warrants.

LLEBG funding of \$24,117, and the required local match of \$2,680 is included in the adopted FY 2001/02 Sheriff's Office budget. There is no net County cost increase.

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office has been identified to receive \$24,117;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has demonstrated its ability to meet the required match of \$2,680; and

WHEREAS, it is required under Department of Justice guidelines that the County Manager shall be the Authorized Grantee Official designated to sign all related award documents, contracts, amendments, or extensions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors by adoption of this resolution hereby agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the grant proposal and authorizes the San Mateo County Manager as agent of the County of San Mateo to execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to application, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
