WHEREAS, SERGEANT ROBERT RANSOM has mentored numerous officers throughout his career and has been an inspiration to his fellow officers; and



WHEREAS, SERGEANT ROBERT RANSOM has served with distinction, honor, courage, loyalty and compassion toward making our community a safer place to live,


