Date: November 5, 2001

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Adopt a resolution authorizing and directing the President of the Board to execute an agreement with the law firm of Foley & Lardner for services and assistance in obtaining supplemental Medi-Cal payments, such as those payments provided under the SB 1255 Program, in the amount of \$50,000.

Background and Discussion:

SB 1255 is a Medi-Cal inpatient supplemental payment program which the State currently operates under federal Medicaid waivers. Unfortunately, participation in the SB 1255 program is limited to disproportionate share hospitals that contract to provide inpatient hospital services to Medi-Cal beneficiaries under the program. At present, although the SMCHC is a disproportionate share hospital, it is not a contract hospital. Because the vast majority of inpatient services provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries by SMCHC is covered under a managed care arrangement with the Health Plan of San Mateo, only a small number of Medi-Cal inpatient days potentially may be contracted for under the program.

Health Services staff have been working with State officials to convince them that there are ways that the State can administratively permit SMCHC to receive supplemental payments under SB 1255, or a similar mechanism. If this strategy does not succeed, then SMCHC will seek legislative remedies.

Due to many legal issues the State is raising in response to SMCHC's proposed solutions, we have recognized the need to retain legal counsel with specific expertise in SB 1255 and who has a relationship with the appropriate State officials. Foley & Lardner, the firm that represents the California Association of Public Hospitals, specializes in health care finance law, and developed the SB 1255 intergovernmental transfer concept. In addition, they work closely with the State officials, who are in the position of providing SMCHC access to the SB 1255 program. In addition to assist the County is gaining access to the SB 1255 program, the firm is qualified to

assist the county in exploring other options to obtain supplemental Medi-Cal payments.

Fiscal Impact:

The contract, as currently proposed, would pay Foley & Lardner, on a time and materials basis, with a cap of \$50,000. The contract includes a termination clause allowing the Board to terminate the contract upon thirty days notice.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND THE LAW FIRM OF FOLEY & LARDNER

THIS AGREEMENT, is entered	into on	, 2001, by and
between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO	O (hereinafter referred to	as "COUNTY"), and the law
firm of FOLEY & LARDNER (hereinaft	ter referred to as "CONT	RACTOR").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to retain CONTRACTOR to represent COUNTY in efforts to obtain supplemental Medi-Cal payments, such as those payments provided under the SB 1255 program; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has both the qualified personnel and expertise to provide such legal and associated services as are necessary and it is ready, willing and able to now provide such services upon request of COUNTY:

WHEREAS, due to the unique qualification of Contractor, the Request for Proposed process need not be utilized:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. CONTRACTOR shall perform legal and associated services on behalf of the County of San Mateo and its officers and employees with regard to assisting and advising the County in obtaining supplemental Medi-Cal payments, such as those payments practiced under the SB 1255 program.

Unless otherwise agreed to by the parties in writing, services under this Agreement shall be performed by, or under the supervision of, Denise Rodriguez, Esq. and Diane Ung, Esq.

2. In consideration for the providing of such legal services as herein described,

COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR at CONTRACTOR's schedule of hourly rates normally charged to public jurisdictions, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

CONTRACTOR shall also be entitled to reimbursement for reasonably incurred costs. However, COUNTY's total obligation under this agreement shall not exceed \$50,000 unless expressly agreed to in writing between CONTRACTOR and COUNTY. Payments will be made within 30 days of receipt of billing by CONTRACTOR.

At such times as hourly rates reflected in Exhibit A are adjusted by CONTRACTOR for general application to its clients, and upon thirty (30) days notice to COUNTY, the schedule of hourly rates in Exhibit A shall be changed to conform with such adjustment.

- 3. In performing the legal services herein agreed upon, CONTRACTOR shall have the status of independent contractor and shall not be deemed to be an officer or employee of the COUNTY.
- 4. CONTRACTOR shall not assign any of its rights or obligations herein contracted for without the written consent of the COUNTY first having been obtained.
- 5. CONTRACTOR shall at all times keep a complete and thorough record of the services and time expended by CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR shall also make available to COUNTY for inspection purposes all of such records so maintained. COUNTY will pay upon billing by CONTRACTOR based upon time and service previously rendered.
- 6. CONTRACTOR shall keep in full force and effect during the term of this Agreement malpractice coverage in the minimum amount of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00).
- 7. This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon the giving of thirty (30) days written notice prior to the effective date of such termination.

8. Contractor agrees to comply with the County's non-discrimination policy and equal benefits ordinance. Specifically, Contractor shall comply with the non-discrimination requirements described in Schedule A which is attached hereto, and incorporated herein.

Violation of the non-discrimination provisions of this Agreement shall be considered a breach of this Agreement and subject Contractor to penalties, to be determined by the County Manager, including, but not limited to:

- i. termination of this Agreement;
- ii. disqualification of Contractor from bidding on or being awarded on aCounty contract for a period of up to three (3) years;
- iii. liquidated damages of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDREDDOLLARS (\$2,500) per violation;
- iv. imposition of other appropriate contractual and civil remedies and sanctions, as determined by the County Manager.

To effectuate the provisions of this paragraph, the County Manager shall have the authority to:

- examine Contractor's employment records with respect to compliance
 with this paragraph;
- ii. set off all or any portion of the amount described in this paragraph against amounts due to Contractor under the Contract or any other contractor between Contractor and County.

With respect to its offices in California, Contractor shall report to the County Manager the filing by any person in any California court of any complaint of discrimination or the filing by and person of any and all charges with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, the Fair Employment and Housing Commission or any other California state entity charged with the investigation of allegations within thirty (30) days of such filing, provided that within such thirty (30) days such entity has not notified Contractor that such charges are dismissed or otherwise unfounded. Such notification shall include the name of the complainant, a copy of such complaint, and a description of the circumstance. Contractor shall provide County with a copy of its response to the complaint when filed.

With respect to the provision of employee benefits, Contractor shall comply with the County Ordinance which prohibits contractors from discriminating in the provision of employee benefits between an employee with a domestic partner and an employee with a spouse.
