**RESOLUTION FINDING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE OR NECESSITY WOULD BE SERVED BY ISSUANCE OF AN OFF-SALE BEER AND WINE LICENSE TO SERGIO RAMOS GUZMAN, LOS PRIMOS MEAT MARKET, FOR THE PREMISES AT 55 FIFTH AVE., SUITE A, REDWOOD CITY**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Business and Professions Code section 23958.4 provides that, upon the request of an applicant for a license to sell liquor, when the granting of the license would result in the "undue concentration" of such establishments, the County must make a determination as to whether the public convenience or necessity would be served by the granting of such license; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has concluded that there is an undue concentration of licenses already issued in the census tract where the property is located; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has received such a request from Sergio Ramos Guzman, Los Primos Meat Market, for an off-sale beer and wine license for the premises at 55 Fifth Ave., Suite A, Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has reviewed the request, and determined to grant same;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that:

1. The public convenience or necessity would be served by the granting of an off-sale beer and wine license to Sergio Ramos Guzman, Los Primos Meat Market, for the premises at 55 Fifth Ave., Suite A, Redwood City.
