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Second Amendment to the Agreement between County of San Mateo and Browning-Ferris Industries of California, Inc. for Landfill Operation

This SECOND AMENDMENT to the Agreement Between County of San Mateo and Browning-Ferris Industries of California, Inc. for Landfill Operation, dated August 17, 1999, (Agreement) and effective as of September 1, 1999, is made by and between Browning-Ferris Industries of California, Inc. (Owner), and the County of San Mateo (County).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Owner and County entered into the Agreement regulating the operation of the Ox Mountain Landfill, including the rates levied for the services provided by the landfill; and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement contemplated that adjustments to the Landfill Rate Schedule (Exhibit B of the Agreement) might be necessary from time to time due to changes in state law or program changes; and,

WHEREAS, two fees paid by Owner from revenues collected by Owner pursuant to the current approved Landfill Rate Schedule (Exhibit B of the Agreement), to wit, the Integrated Waste Management Fee levied by the State of California, and the fee paid to recycle computer monitors and televisions received at the landfill, have increased or will increase on July 1, 2002, and Owner has requested an increase in the affected rates in the Landfill Rate Schedule (Exhibit B of the Agreement) to be effective on July 1, 2002, to offset said increases, and the County concurs with Owners request.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

Exhibit B – Landfill Rate Schedule of the Agreement shall be superceded and replaced by *Exhibit B*— *Revised, Landfill Rate Schedule, Effective July 1, 2002*, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference; which Exhibit B—Revised reflects an increase effective July 1, 2002, of \$0.06 per ton in the tipping rate charged for waste received at the landfill as tonnage, and establishes effective July 1, 2002, Special Rates of \$15.00 per computer monitor or television with less than a 21-inch diagonal screen and \$25.00 per computer monitor or television with a 21 inch diagonal screen or larger.

In all other respects, the Agreement shall remain unchanged.
