AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 04060

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Part 12 of the Ordinance is amended as indicated:

**ORGANIZATION 17000 EMPLOYEE AND PUBLIC SERVICES**

1. Item B132, Administrative Assistant I - unclassified, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 0 positions.
2. Item B189S, Community Program Specialist - unclassified series, is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.

**ORGANIZATION 19500 CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FIRST PROGRAM**

1. The salary for item B247, Executive Director, Children and Families First Program, is changed to range 5157.

**ORGANIZATION 30000 SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

1. Item G050, Crime Analyst, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
2. Item B010, Crime Analyst - unclassified, is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.

**ORGANIZATION 37000 COUNTY LIBRARY**

1. Item B182S, Community Program Specialist - unclassified series, is increased by 1 position for a new total of 2 positions.

ORGANIZATION 70000 HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY

1. Item V235, Information Technology Analyst, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 7 positions.
2. Item E406S, Storekeeper series, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 0 positions.
3. Item T064S, Utility Worker series, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
4. Item E410, Storekeeping Supervisor, is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 0 positions.
5. Item V240, Information Technology Supervisor, is increased by 1 position for a new total of 4 positions.
6. Item E460S, Records Center Assistant series, is increased by 2 position for a new total of 4 positions.
7. Item E473, Records Center Supervisor, is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.

**SECTION 2.** Part Organization 19500 of this ordinance is effective on October 1, 2001. All other parts of this ordinance are effective at the start of the first pay period 30 days following adoption.
