## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY GRANT AND USED OIL BLOCK GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and maintaining local used oil and household hazardous waste collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate disposal; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state, setting up necessary procedures governing the application by cities and counties under the program; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo will enter into an agreement with the State of California for implementation of a used oil collection program; and

WHEREAS, funds totaling \$1.5 million dollars have been established pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 43230 and are available from the California Integrated Waste Management Account for grants to Local Enforcement Agencies to support solid waste facilities permit and inspection;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of an application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a Local Enforcement Agency Grant and Used Oil Grant. The Director of Environmental Health of San Mateo County is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of San Mateo County all necessary applications, contracts, agreements and amendments for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purpose specified in the application.
