RESOLUTION CONFIRMING COMMITMENT TO PAYMENT OF PREVAILING WAGES

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the federal government and the California Legislature have deemed it necessary and thereafter provided legal justification and basis for imposing the payment of prevailing wages upon all federal, state and local public projects; and

WHEREAS, the legislative purposes of prevailing wages are to obtain well qualified, competent and efficient workers, to provide a higher trained and more experienced work force and to assist such workers to meet the current high cost of living; and

WHEREAS, the payment of prevailing wages for particular projects will enhance employment opportunities and thereby promote the local economy; and

WHEREAS, a higher trained and more experienced work force will enhance the safety of all persons working in a construction project, and reduce the likelihood of serious or disabling construction related accidents; and WHEREAS, a more highly trained and experienced work force will ensure that infrastructure, structures and facilities are constructed in a timely fashion and reflect quality workmanship, thereby protecting the health and safety of future occupants and users of such structures and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the prevailing wage law of California has recently been amended; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to reaffirm its support for the payment of prevailing wages as required by law.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows: It is hereby confirmed that it is the policy and practice of this Board to comply with all applicable prevailing wage laws.
