## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE GIFT OF FUNDS TO OFFSET COSTS INCURRED IN THE ADVISORY ELECTION REGARDING THE EXTENSION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MIDPENINSULA REGIONAL OPEN SPACE DISTRICT

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council has requested the Board of Supervisors to place on the November 5, 2002 ballot, an advisory measure asking the voters south of the City of Half Moon Bay and west of Skyline Boulevard if they want that territory, to the extent it is not currently a part of the District, to be included within the boundaries of the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District; and

WHEREAS, the cost of placing the advisory measure on the ballot and the costs associated with publishing the required notice and printing the required ballot materials has been estimated to total approximately \$2,900, and

WHEREAS, the members of the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council have indicated that funding could be raised from members of the south coast community to donate to the County to offset the costs of the advisory election; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 25355 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to accept or reject any gift made to the County for any public purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of this Board of Supervisors be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to accept as a gift to the County of San Mateo, funding raised to off-set the cost incurred in placing on the November 5, 2002 ballot, an advisory measure asking the voters south of the City of Half Moon Bay and west of Skyline Boulevard if the Midpenisula Regional Open Space District should extend its boundary to include territory not currently within the District which is generally described as west of Skyline Boulevard to the San Mateo County Coast and south of the City of Half Moon Bay to the Santa Cruz County line.
