RESOLUTION FINDING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE OR NECESSITY WOULD <u>NOT</u> BE SERVED BY ISSUANCE OF AN OFF-SALE BEER AND WINE LICENSE TO GUZMAN SERGIO RAMOS FOR THE PREMISES AT LOS PRIMOS MEAT MARKET, 55 FIFTH AVE., SUITE A, REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Business and Professions Code section 23958.4 provides that, upon the request of an applicant for a license to sell liquor, when the granting of the license would result in the "undue concentration" of such establishments, the County must make a determination as to whether the public convenience or necessity would be served by the granting of such license; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has concluded that there is an undue concentration of licenses already issued in the census tract where the property is located; and

WHEREAS, the County has received such a request from Sergio Ramos Guzman, Los Primos Meat Market, for an off-sale beer and wine license for the premises at 55 Fifth Ave., Suite A, Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the request, and determined to deny same;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. The public convenience or necessity would <u>not</u> be served by the granting of an off-sale beer and wine license to Sergio Ramos Guzman, Los Primos Meat

Market, for the premises at 55 Fifth Ave., Suite A, Redwood City.
