NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County extend their congratulations to THE NATIVITY OF THE HOLY VIRGIN upon its milestone 50th Anniversary and best wishes for his continued dedication and service to the community.
