THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

WITH DELOITTE CONSULTING

FOR CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE DATA WAREHOUSE PROJECT AND THE GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS PILOT PROJECT

THIS	S AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT, entered into on this	day
of	, 2002, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, h	ereinafter called
"Coun	ity," and Deloitte Consulting, hereinafter called "Contractor".	

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement on March 1, 2001, for the purpose of Deloitte Consulting to provide consulting services to San Mateo County for the Data Warehouse Project; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment on August 7, 2001, extending the term of the Agreement, increasing the amount and adding the transitional phase of the Data Warehouse Project.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Second Amendment on February 26, 2002, for the purpose of extending the term of the Agreement, increasing the amount, adding the Outcome-Based Management Data Development Project and the Support & Training Project, both are an extension of the Data Warehouse Project; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to further amend the Agreement to extend the term, increase the amount and add the Geographic Information Systems Pilot Project, another extension of the Data Warehouse Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **Section 1: Exhibits** is hereby amended to add the following:
 - Exhibit J: Statement of Work SHARP Data Warehouse GIS
- 2. **Section 3:** <u>Term</u> is hereby amended to read as follows:

The term of the Agreement shall be from 3/1/01 to 6/30/03.

3. **Section 4: <u>Payments</u>** is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services rendered in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein in Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and attachment E, County shall make payments to Contractor in the manner specified in Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and attachment E. In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amount in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination. In no event shall total payment under this Agreement exceed \$2,426,735, of which \$1,715,090 is

for Data Warehouse services, \$388,500 is for the OBM project, \$130,505 is for Informatica software purchased through Deloitte Consulting and \$192,640 is for the Geographic Information Systems Pilot Project.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement dated March 1, 2001, and subsequent Amendments, between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.






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SHARP Data Warehouse - GIS Project

The Human Services Agency (HSA) of San Mateo County developed a data warehouse (SHARP) to integrate data from various systems within the Agency. Currently the SHARP data warehouse contains County client information. The County has now identified the need to have a Geographic Information System (GIS) to plot the client information in a geographical map. Deloitte Consulting will be retained to:

- Establish Methodology for the GIS implementation.
- Explore the features and capabilities of GIS.
- Perform knowledge transfer activities to County staff.
- Integrate with the countywide GIS and SHARP data warehouse.
- Generate the first set of maps.

To accomplish the above listed goals Deloitte Consulting will:

- I. Define the GIS Pilot Business Requirements.
- II. Design and Develop GIS Maps.
- III. Conduct Testing.
- IV. Move to Production.

Scope of Work

I. Define GIS Pilot Business Requirements

The County will identify the functional and technical requirements for the development of the GIS functionality. As directed by the County Project Manager, Deloitte Consulting will conduct interviews with key stakeholders and hold sessions to identify requirements for the creation of the geographic maps to display spatial data using a GIS mapping tool.

Deloitte Consulting will assist the County in prioritizing the requirements of GIS and advise the County on the scope of work that can be completed within the specific term of the agreement.

Criteria for this decision will include the scope relevance to County strategic goals, data availability (in the SHARP Data Warehouse) and data quality, and staff availability.

County Responsibilities

- Participate in GIS requirements sessions to provide specific mapping requirements.
- Prioritize business requirements and determine final scope of work.

Deloitte Responsibilities:

- Coordinate and facilitate the GIS requirements sessions with key functional and technical stakeholders.
- Identify the HSA mapping requirements.
- Identify key data loading requirements.



- Provide HSA with prioritization criteria for business requirements.
- Recommend final scope to SHARP Steering Committee.

Deliverables

· GIS Business Requirements Document.

Completion Criteria

- Completed GIS requirement sessions.
- Review and acceptance of Business Requirements Document by SHARP Steering Committee.

II. Design and Develop GIS Maps1

Deloitte Consulting will design and create geographic maps based on the final business requirements. In addition, Deloitte Consulting will develop standards for the implementation of geographic maps including standard fonts, colors, templates etc.

County Responsibilities

- Assist with design of geographic maps and development of standards.
- Provide data extracts from the SHARP data warehouse.
- Determine appropriate procedures for refreshing the data, and determine the users of the geographic maps.

Deloitte Responsibilities:

- Provide the requirement of the data extract to SHARP team.
- Create design standards for GIS development.
- Design geographic map template.
- Match data extracts to geographic map requirements.
- Identify and resolve data quality issues.
- Create geographic map and associated help text.

Deliverables

GIS Design and Implementation document.

Completion Criteria

 The geographic maps created during this phase will address the needs outlined in the Business Requirements Document (submitted at the end of - I. Define GIS Pilot Business Requirements).

III. Conduct Testing

Deloitte Consulting will assist the County, to create a test plan and utilize the test discrepancy resolution process that was implemented for the SHARP project. Once the geographic maps are developed the County users will be able to test the functionality of these maps using the GIS mapping tool. The County will complete resolution and retesting of testing issues.

County Responsibilities

- Create testing plan.
- Install and test GIS mapping tool for County testing.
- Identify and provide adequate resources for testing tasks.
- Modify maps to resolve test discrepancies.
- Develop test discrepancy resolution process.
- Retest test discrepancies.

Deloitte Responsibilities:

- Assist in the development of the testing plan.
- Provide technical support to county testers.
- Modify the geographic maps to resolve test discrepancies.

Deliverables

• Test Results Document.

Completion Criteria

• Review and acceptance of the Test Results Document by SHARP Steering Committee.

IV. Move to Production

Production data will be loaded, and geographic maps will be migrated to the production environment.

County Responsibilities

- Validate data quality prior to production load.
- Migrate final geographic maps from testing to the production environment.

Deloitte Responsibilities:

• Ensure successful migration from testing to production environment.

Deliverables

Completed GIS Data Load.

Completion Criteria

Review and acceptance of GIS data load by SHARP steering committee.

Deloitte Consulting Pricing

Deloitte Consulting will invoice HSA using a blended, hourly rate for all staff of \$215 for the GIS Project. This rate is inclusive of all expenses associated with this effort. The total cost associated with this effort will not exceed \$192,640 based on 896 labor hours.

Deloitte Consulting has will bring on a project team that we believe can complete the tasks outlined in this Scope of Work within the project time frames. Any changes to this staffing model may impact the work plan, blended rate and/or total project cost. Change to the total cost will require a contract amendment.

Key Assumptions

The following are key assumptions for the Geographic Information Systems Pilot Development.

- The extent of Deloitte Consulting's involvement in the Geographic Information functionality for the SHARP Data Warehouse development will be from 08/05/2002 to 10/18/2002.
- Deloitte Consulting will invoice HSA on a monthly basis. For a given month, the invoice will be based upon each staff member's actual hours worked on the project multiplied by the blended hourly rate of \$215.
- Deloitte Consulting will work with the County to finalize the work plan for the Geographic Information functionality for the SHARP Data Warehouse Development. This work plan will clearly document the responsibilities of the County and Deloitte Consulting. This work plan must be finalized within 2 weeks of the starting of the project.
- The County will adhere to the schedule and allotted times for each of County's tasks as agreed to by County and Deloitte Consulting Project Managers. Delays in the completion of any or all of County's tasks will extend the scheduled completion dates for subsequent tasks and work of both County and Deloitte Consulting by a corresponding amount.
- The County must identify 2-3 users for the GIS functionality for the SHARP Data Warehouse.
- The County Project Manager will be responsible for identifying the requirements team.
- The County must select, procure and install the GIS tool in a timely manner so as not to have an adverse impact on the productive work and schedule for the implementation of GIS functionality for the SHARP data warehouse.



- The selection, procurement and installation of the GIS mapping tool will be the responsibility of the County. Deloitte Consulting will play an assistance role during this task.
- The development of the extracts from the SHARP Data Warehouse will be the responsibility of the County. Deloitte Consulting will provide the extract specifications.
- Deloitte Consulting will revise the work plan after the completion of the GIS Pilot Business Requirements Definition Phase. Criteria for this decision will include relevance of requirements to County strategic goals, data availability, data quality, and resource availability. This revised work plan will include the final business requirements that may be completed in the remaining time and budget.





Figure 1: Map of Drop in Locations in Allegheny County




Figure 2: Map of Case Management Offices and Facility Locations
