Due to a reorganization of MSMC in 1994, the welfare exemption pursuant to § 214 of the Revenue & Taxation code and previously granted to this property, no longer applied and should have been removed. This error was discovered in 2000.

MSMC was contacted and new claim forms to file for the welfare exemption were mailed. All required information was not submitted by MSMC until December 2001.

The claim was submitted to the State Board of Equalization in December and approval of the welfare exemption was received in April of 2002.

Approval of the roll correction completed for the 2001 annual roll is being requested.
