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RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF DALY CITY - DALY CITY COMMUNITY SERVICE CENTER TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE AND OTHER SERVICES TO RESIDENTS OF BROADMOOR, COLMA AND DALY CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY TO EXECUTE SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND MINOR MODIFICATIONS NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 PER FUNDING SOURCE

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in the best interest of the County of San Mateo would be served by waiver of the Request for Proposal, in that Daly City Community Service Center agrees to provide these Core services to the residents of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for it consideration and acceptance an Agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Daly City Community Services Center agrees to provide to the County of San Mateo, information, referral, general assistance, case management, support counseling, emergency material assistance, and employment related activities to persons in need; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such Agreement and said Board has examined and approved same as to both form and content and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Human Services Agency shall be authorized to execute subsequent Amendments and modifications to this Agreement during the term of the Agreement, provided however, that such authority is limited to (a) reducing or increasing the County's maximum fiscal obligation in the event that there is a commensurate reduction or increase in funding received by the County, provided, however, that such increases shall be limited to a total of \$25,000 per funding source; and (b) making changes in the types of services and activities provided by Contractor, provided that the changes have no impact on the County's maximum fiscal obligation to the Contractor.

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
