RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

THE PERFORMANCE GROUP and NOTRE DAME de NAMUR UNIVERSITY

IN RECOGNITION OF THE MUSICAL GIFT TO THE COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, on this month of December, two thousand and two, THE PERFORMANCE GROUP and NDNU celebrate 17 years of the free performance of Charles Dickens' "A Christmas Carol" for thousands of Bay Area families; and

WHEREAS, THE PERFORMANCE GROUP and NDNU's production features over twenty musical numbers performed by nearly 100 actors, singers and dancers dressed in colorful Victorian era costumes, presented on Notre Dame Theatre's stage with a two story set forty-five feet wide and seventeen feet tall; and

WHEREAS, THE PERFORMANCE GROUP and NDNU offer eight performances free of charge and attendees are asked to donate new toys or non-perishable foods at the theatre for the benefit of Peninsula families; and

WHEREAS, THE PERFORMANCE GROUP and NDNU collected 3½ tons of food and over 1,800 toys in 2001 which were then given for distribution to the South County Fire Department Toys-for-Tots volunteers, Samaritan House in San Mateo, St. Anthony's Padua Dining Room in Menlo Park, the Bayshore Community Resource Center in East Palo Alto, Elipse - San Mateo County Aids Foundation and the Family Resource Center in San Mateo; and


