SUBJECT Services at Coastside Clinic

The purpose of this memo is to inform your committee of the status of expanded services provided in Half Moon Bay by the Health System, in light of the closure of the Coastside Family Health Clinic.

San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) began to provide pediatric services at the County's Coastside Clinic in Half Moon Bay on Tuesday, May 5. Pediatric services are available in the clinic on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, from 8 AM-4:30 PM. Over the next 3-6 months we hope to expand the days of pediatric services and eventually serve 1,000 children from the coastal community. The clinic will serve those families on Medi-Cal, Healthy Families and Healthy Kids. Well-child and sick visits will be by appointment only. The clinic is located on the second floor at 225 South Cabrillo Highway, Half Moon Bay.

Staffing for the clinic includes a Pediatrician or a Pediatric Nurse Practitioner, Registered Nurse, Certified Medical Assistant, and Patient Services Assistance.

The expanded services offered are in addition to other County-provided services at this location. Those other services include Obstetrics and Gynecology on Thursdays (days and evenings) and Fridays, Primary Care on Mondays, and a full array of mental health services offered daily by the Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Division. In addition, the site is used by the community-based RotaCare Clinic on Wednesday evenings.
