## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATION LIMITS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002-03

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on November 6, 1979, California voters passed Proposition 4, an initiative to restrict government spending by establishing limits on the annual appropriations of local agencies;

WHEREAS, Proposition 4 added Article XIIIB to the California State constitution; (commencing with Section 7900) to Title I of the Government Code prescribing procedures to be used in implementing Article XIIIB;

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California Constitution was amended by Proposition 111;

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 7910 requires local jurisdictions to establish by resolution their Appropriation Limit each year for the following fiscal year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors that the Appropriation Limit for the County of San Mateo and certain Board governed special districts for the 2002-03 fiscal year shall be \$294,426,662; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the documentation used in the computation of the aforementioned Appropriation Limit be made available to the public for review in the Office of the County Manager.
