Re: Appointment to Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors appoint Leslie Fiering to a vacancy on the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council for a term to conclude with the November election in 2006.

BACKGROUND:

Maeva Neale chose not to run for re-election to the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council last November. Jim Schweickert filed to run for the seat previously held by Maeva Neale. Jim Schweickert was the only individual to file for the seat and he was elected in November. Unfortunately, Mr. Schweickert recently passed away.

Under the rules and regulations established by the Board of Supervisors for the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council, the PMAC interviews candidates and makes a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors when there are vacancies on the PMAC. At its meeting of December 12, 2002, the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council unanimously recommended that Leslie Fiering be appointed to fill the vacancy created by the death of Jim Schweickert.

Leslie Fiering will represent PMAC District 2 along the coast south of Pescadero Road. Ms. Fiering will serve until the November election in 2006.
