WHEREAS, POLICE CHIEF TIMOTHY J. GUINEY is, after twelve years as Police Chief, modestly continuing his service with the Broadmoor Police Department as the volunteer Assistant Chief of Police. Tim Guiney is a Cop's Cop. He truly cares for the welfare of each of his officers in his department. Chief Guiney views law enforcement as an outreach effort and has a rare and refreshing approach to community policing.
