WHEREAS, the SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE was a strong supporter of the efforts to construct the famous sign on the hills above the City in 1923 claiming it an industrial city; and

WHEREAS, the SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE has grown substantially in membership and responsibilities by providing numerous opportunities for businesses and the community including business mixers and luncheons, information sharing, seminars, community events and a fundraiser to support the Chamber's scholarship fund for local students; and

WHEREAS, the SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE is still going strong after 90 years and continues to improve upon the betterment of the business community and the quality of life for South San Francisco,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County commends and congratulates the SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE on its 90th anniversary and wishes it continued success in its future endeavors.
