RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO OPPOSITION TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION'S PROPOSED RATE-SETTING OF "EXIT FEES" RELATED TO SOLAR POWER

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors support solar power generation as a sustainable, environmental and politically conscious method of reducing the County's reliance on fossil fuels that harm the environment;

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors, in support of the state and nations effort to reduce our reliance on fossil fuels and to promote sustainable energy practices, developed and installed a solar power generation system for the San Mateo County Crime Lab facility;

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Crime Lab facility generates approximately 270,000 kilowatt hours of solar power each year and reduces the County's reliance on external power sources by an equal amount;

WHEREAS, the California Public Utilities Commission will consider proposed ratesetting actions related to "exit fees" that would have, in part, the effect of taxing the selfgeneration of solar power and deter the further and future development of solar power; and NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors by the adoption of this resolution hereby opposes the California Public Utilities Commission's proposed rate-setting of "exit fees" as they relate to solar power.
