WHEREAS, RUSSELL MOSS played an active role in education by serving as a member of the California School Board Association, the SSFUSD Strategic Planning Committee, the South San Francisco High School Accreditation Committee, and as an elected official of the SSFUSD Board of Directors; and

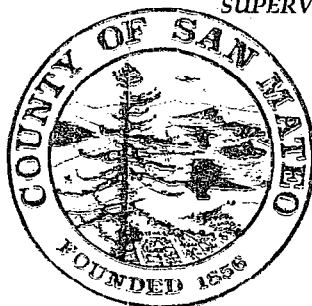
