**WHEREAS**, on December 2, 1980, the Board of Supervisors entered into a Cable Franchise Agreement with Peninsula Cable TV for unincorporated areas in North Fair Oaks and Sequoia/Greenwood; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 11, 1985, the Board of Supervisors entered into a Cable Franchise Agreement with Vista Grande Cablevision for the unincorporated Broadmoor area (collectively, with the Peninsula Cable TV Franchise Agreement, the "Original Agreements"); and

**WHEREAS**, in 1986, the Board of Supervisors approved the merger of Vista Grande Cablevision into Tele-Communications, Incorporated ("TCI"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors extended the Agreements until September 30, 1995; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 19th day of November 1985, the Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of control of Capital Cities Communications, Inc. to the Washington Post Company d.b.a. Pacific Cable Television; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 1996, the Board of Supervisors extended the term of the Agreement until the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1997; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 7th day of January, 1997, the Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of control of Post-Newsweek Pacific Cable, Inc. (successor to Washington Post Company) to TCI American Cable Holdings II, L.P.; and

**WHEREAS**, did on July 22, 1997, the Board of Supervisors extended the term of the Agreement until the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 22, 1996, the Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of control of Western Cabled Systems to TCI Cablevision of Georgia, Inc. ("TCI"); and

**WHEREAS**, on October 20, 1998, the Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of control of TCI to AT & T Corp.; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 19, 1999, the Board of Supervisors approved an extension of the Agreement for the Skyline/Kings Mountain, Skylonda and Los Trancos areas until March 1, 2003, with TCI; and
